First day NSS Volunteers cleaned the surrounding area of Camp Resident.



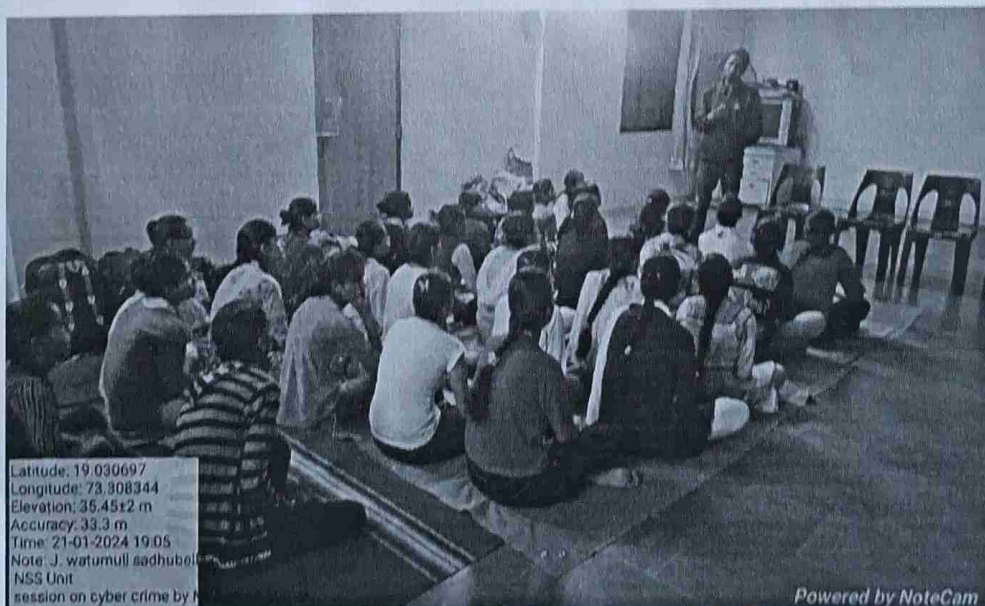

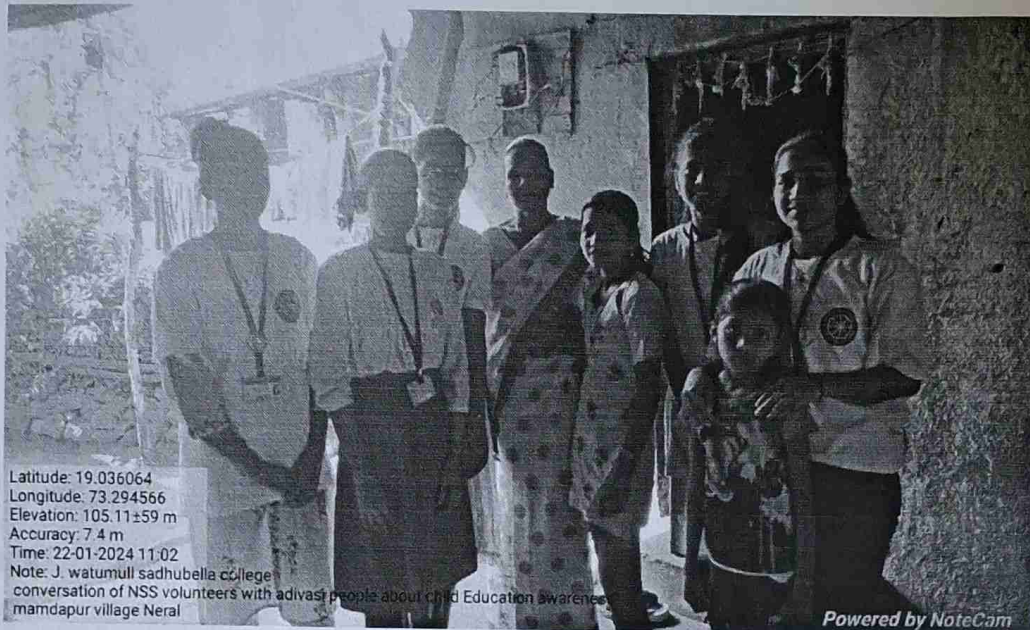

Same day in the evening NSS Volunteers and Professor have distributed sweets among Adivasis students at Neral on the occasion of Dipotsav.

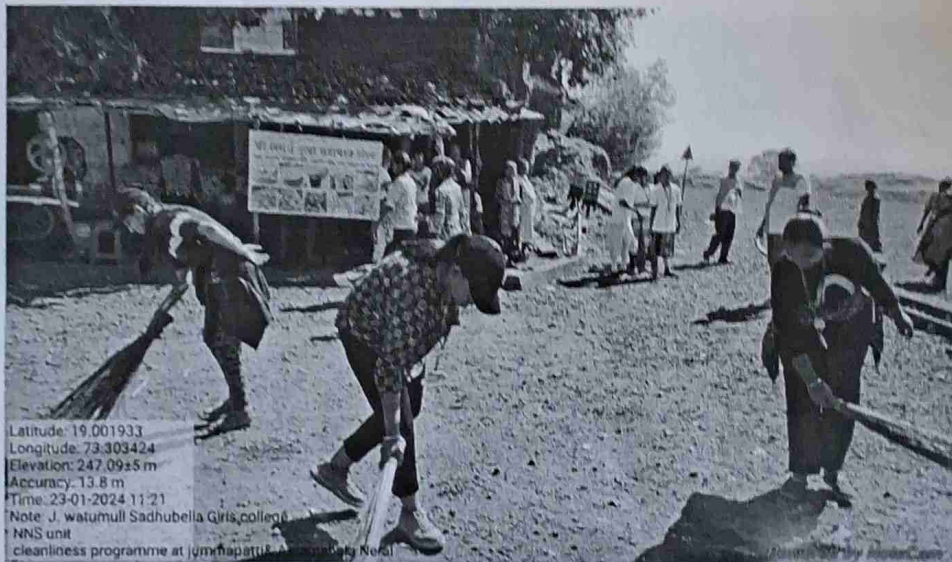

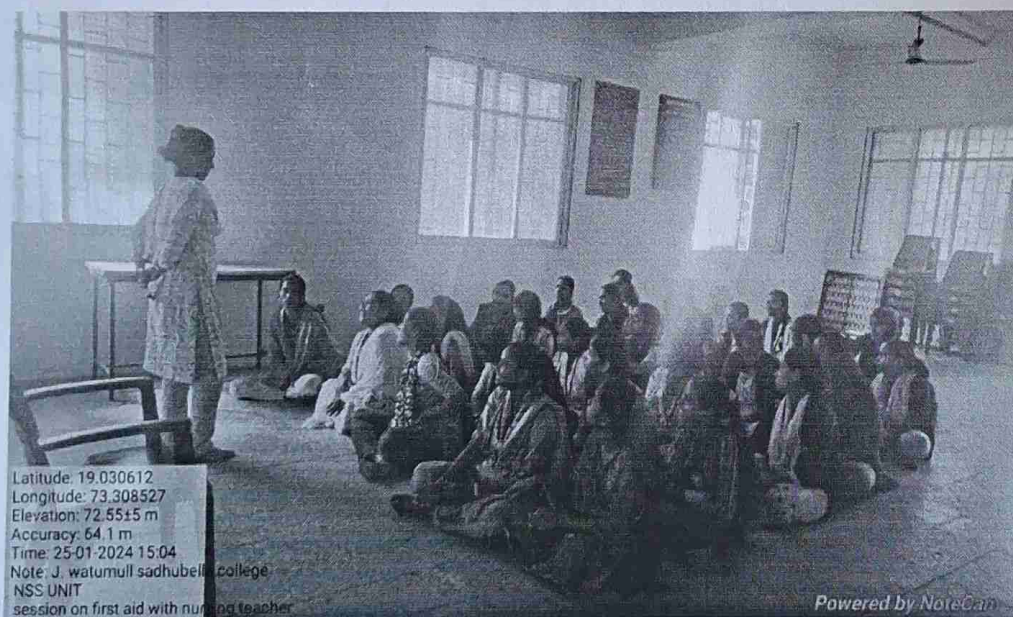

Medical team of Kotwalwadi trust has been given a lecture to the students about how to use the first aid box in emergency.

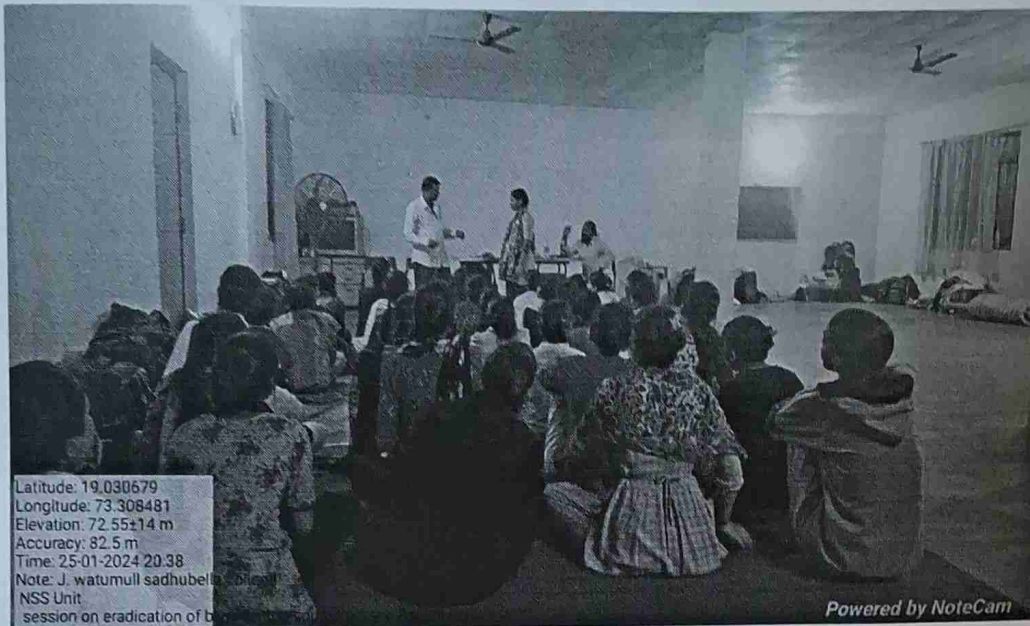


NSS volunteers has also taught to the Adivasi students and also guided them about examination preparation.





In the evening session of Rajesh Koli has given a lecture on the topic of eradication of superstition. Students participated in his activity. Students enjoyed a lot and also got knowledge

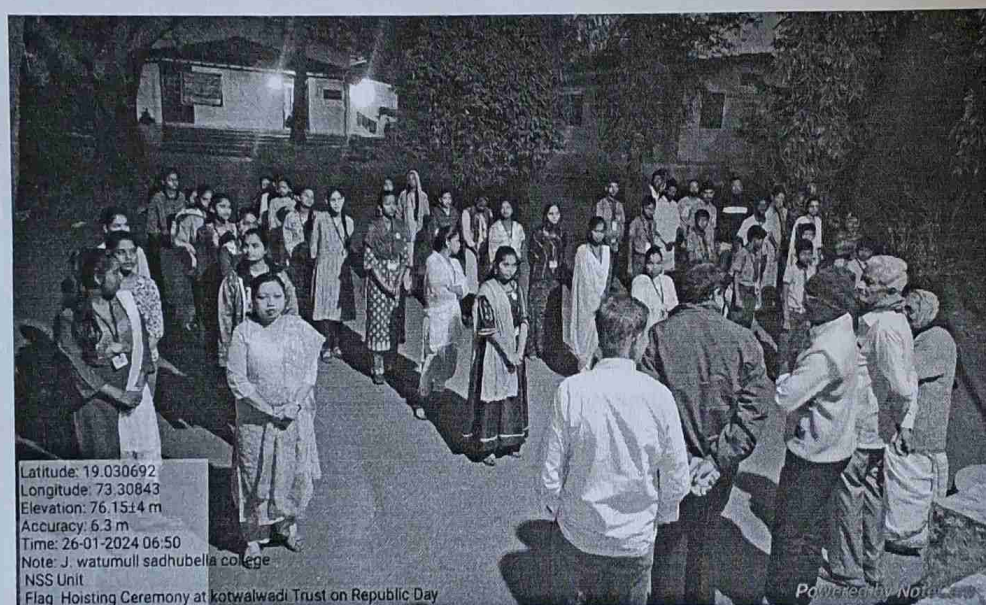
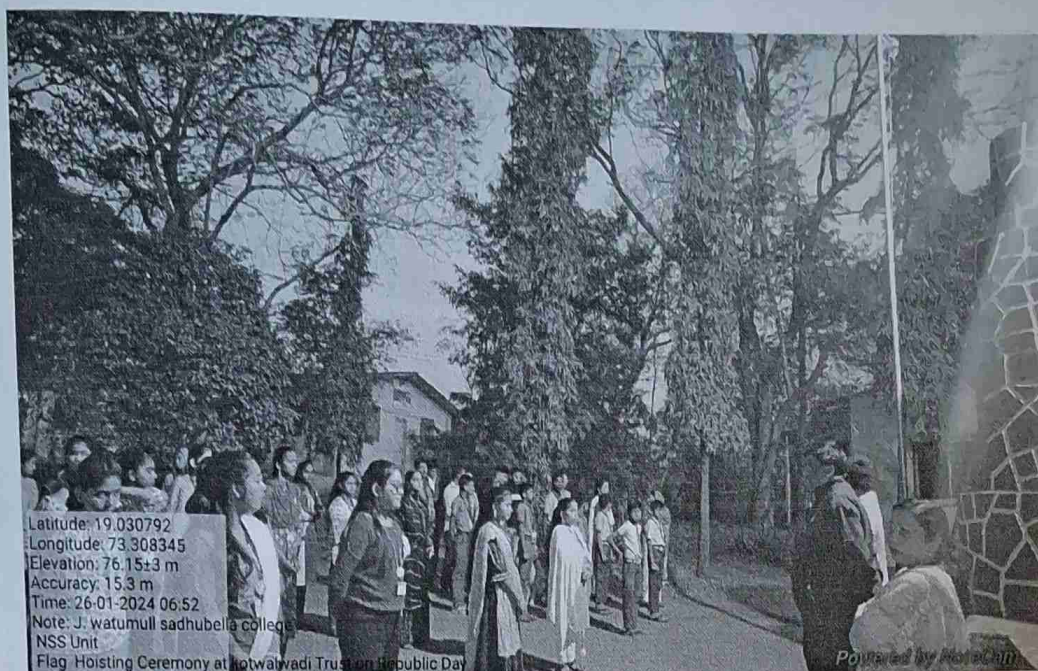

Patriotic song and Dances on the Occasion on Republic Day

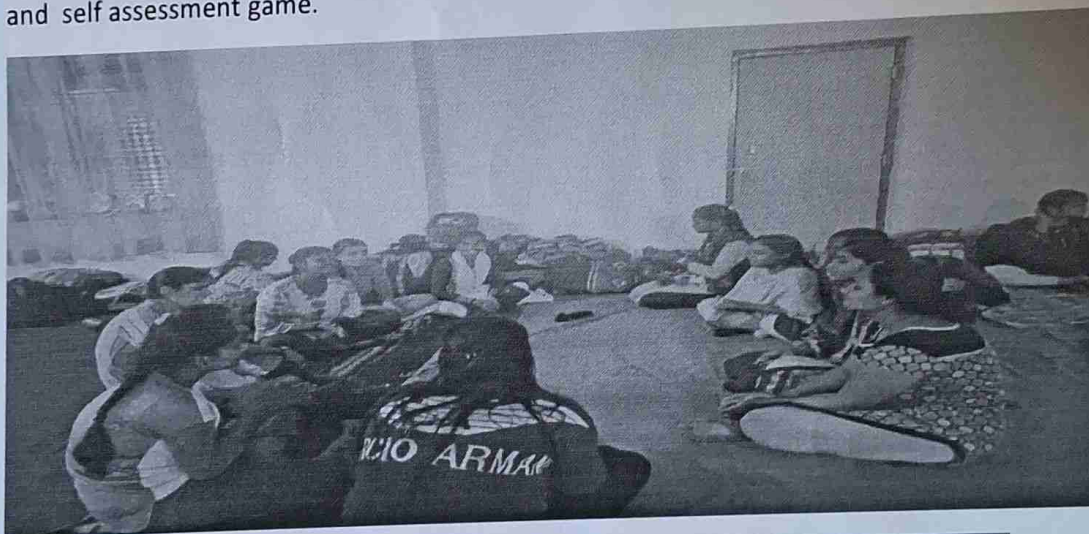

Seminar start with the national anthem. After that co-ordinator Mrs. Neetu purswani and other staff members and ABVP Team lighted the lamp



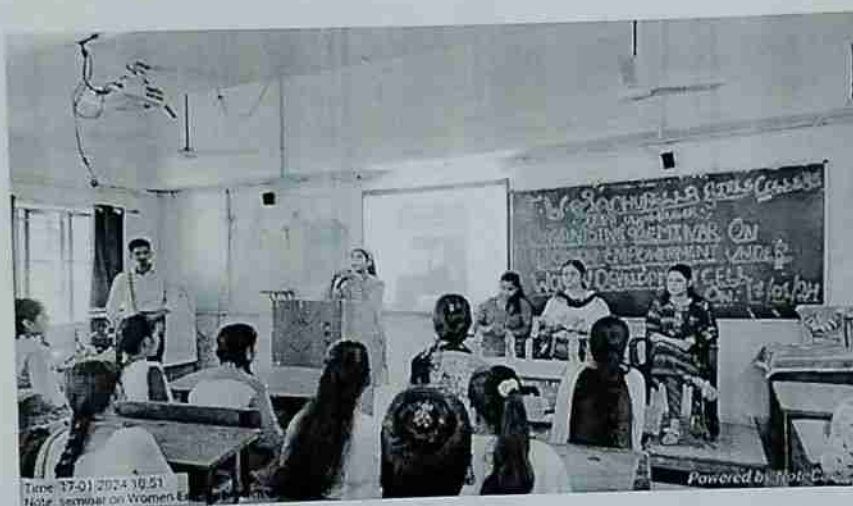
