Annual picnic cum educational tour- under the subject head environmental studies

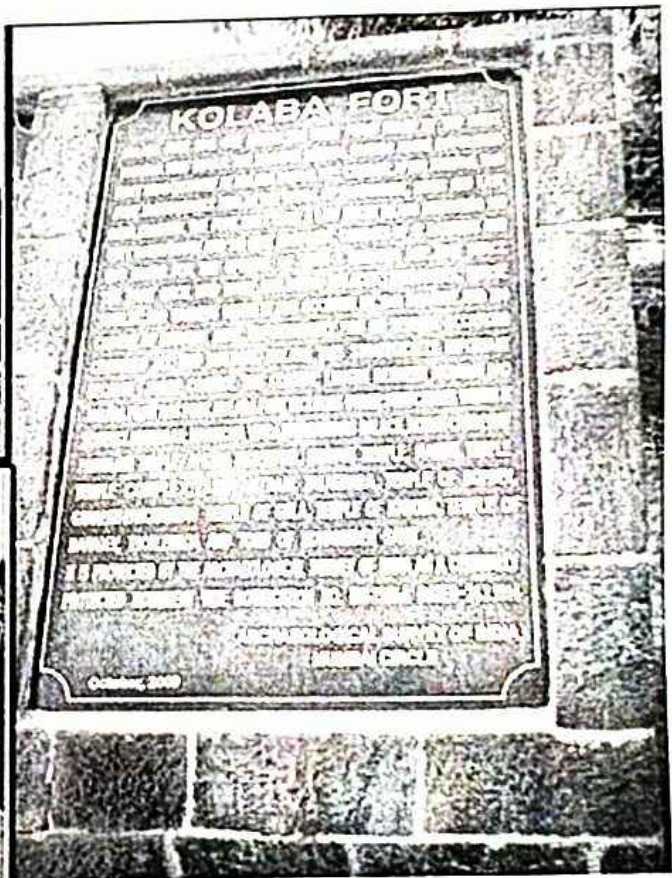
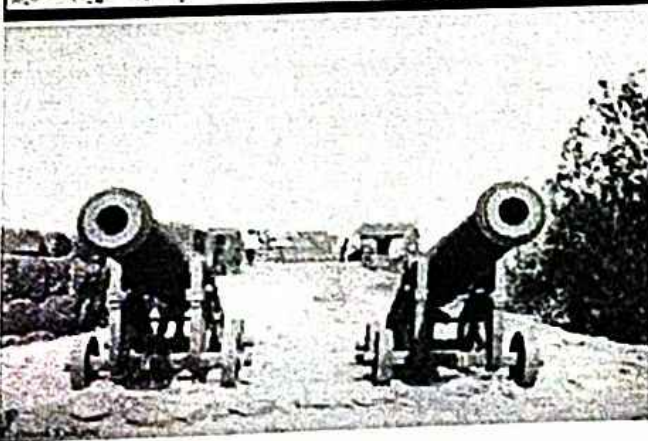
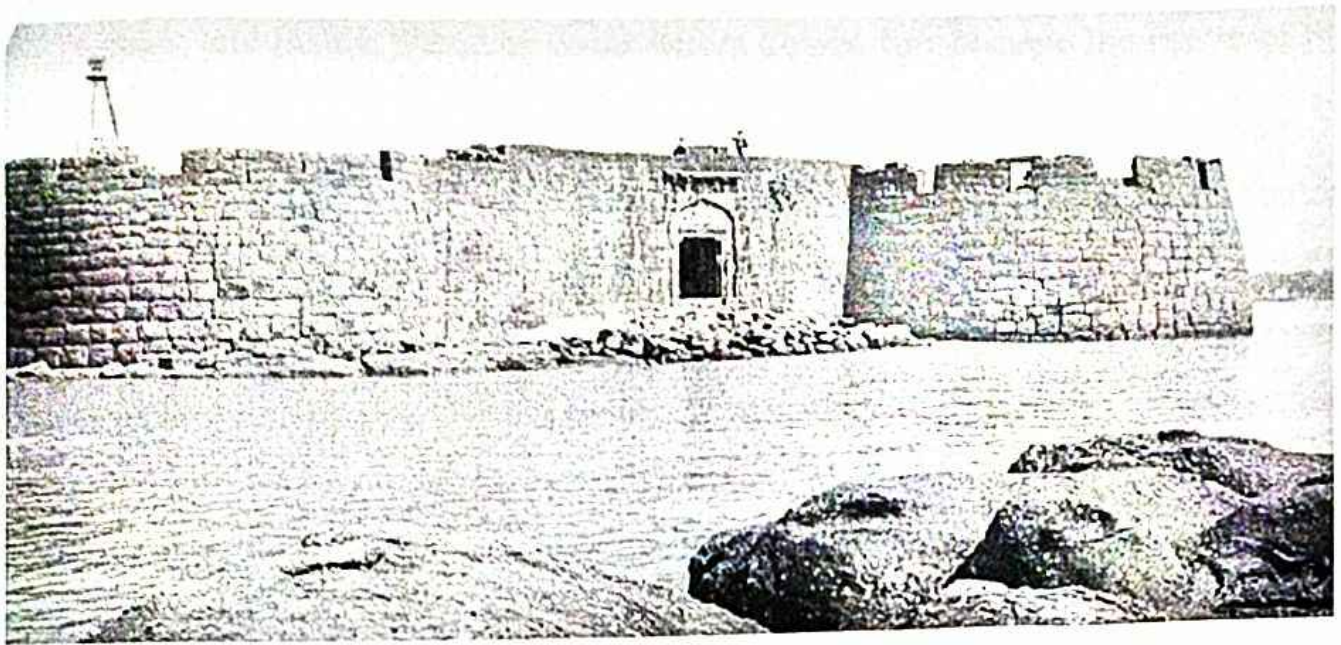
On 3<sup>rd</sup> february, 2017, the college organised a educational tour to Alibag for all the students. As Alibag is famous for coastal tourism and for historical places so the said tour was under the subject head EVS.

Alibag is located about 120 km south of Mumbai, . It is a tourist place.the district government offices are located along the sea coast road. Alibag is the center place of Raigad district.

In all 52 students of Fy/Sy/Ty Bcom participated. Prof. Rajesh kumar singh and prof. Kiran Menghani along with one nonteaching staff accompanied . The batch of 52 students were taken through road transportation through bus facility. At 7.00 am, the bus started from the college premises. The attendance of the students were taken off the bus and in the bus. All reached the spot at 11.00 where the first visit was paid to Alibag beach where on a little distance there was a colaba fort. Students embraced the beauty of nature on the beach where few of the students also rode a water bike and then all were taken to the fort where the historical importance was explained by the professors. The fort was very old and it had various other monuments attached to it.

Students were also given pleasure of horse cart ride. As there was high tide, and the water level in the sea rose, so th facility of horse cart ride was used, students also clicked photos and also did a video shooting of the same.



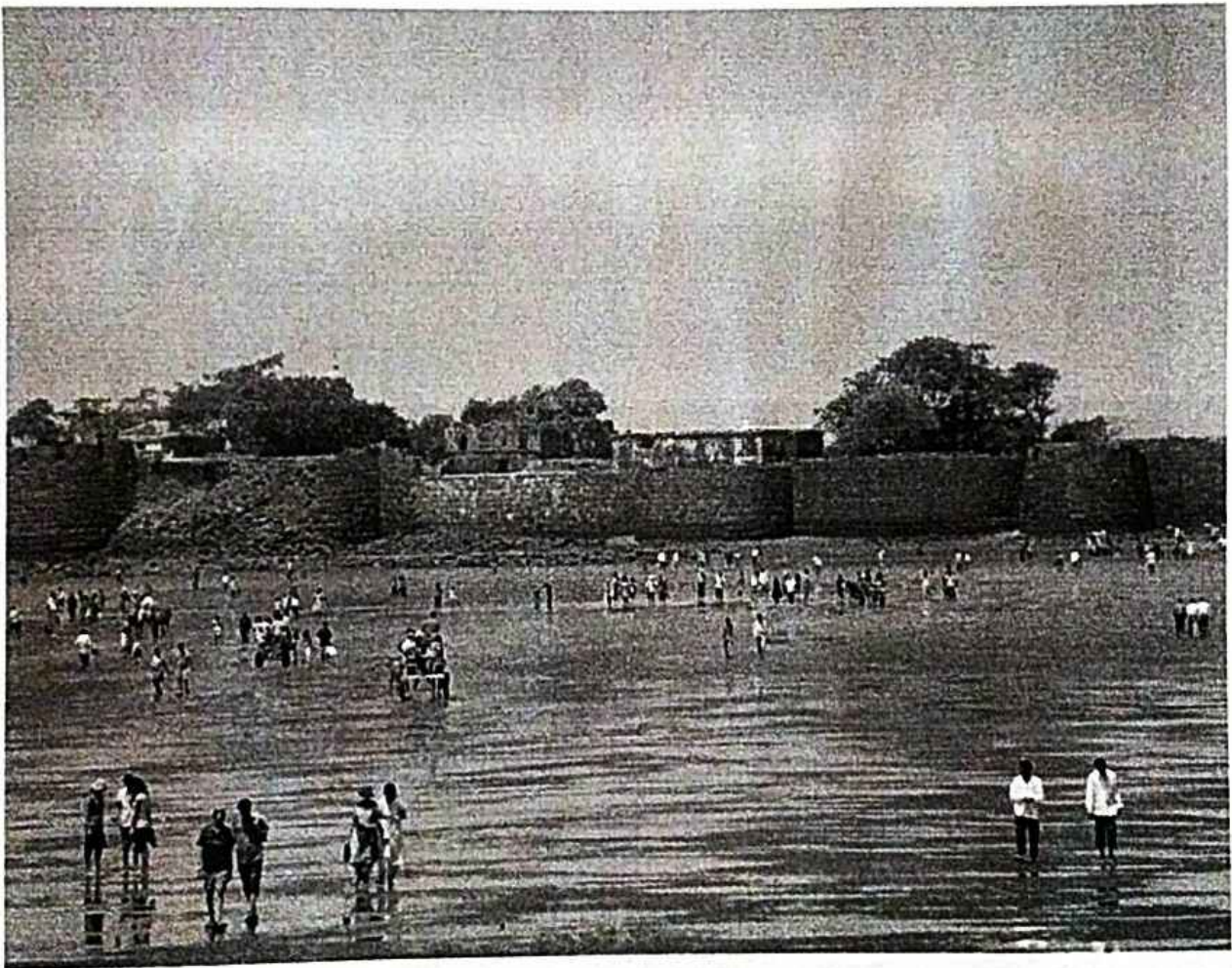


The first mention of kolaba fort is when it was chosen by shivaji maharaj to be fortified after the whole of south konkan became free. The work of construction of the fort started in 19 march 1680. In 1662, he strengthened and fortified kolaba fort to make it one of his chief naval stations. the command of the fort was given to



darya sagar and manik bhandari under whom kolaba fort became the centre of the maratha attacks on british ships. kolaba fort is one of

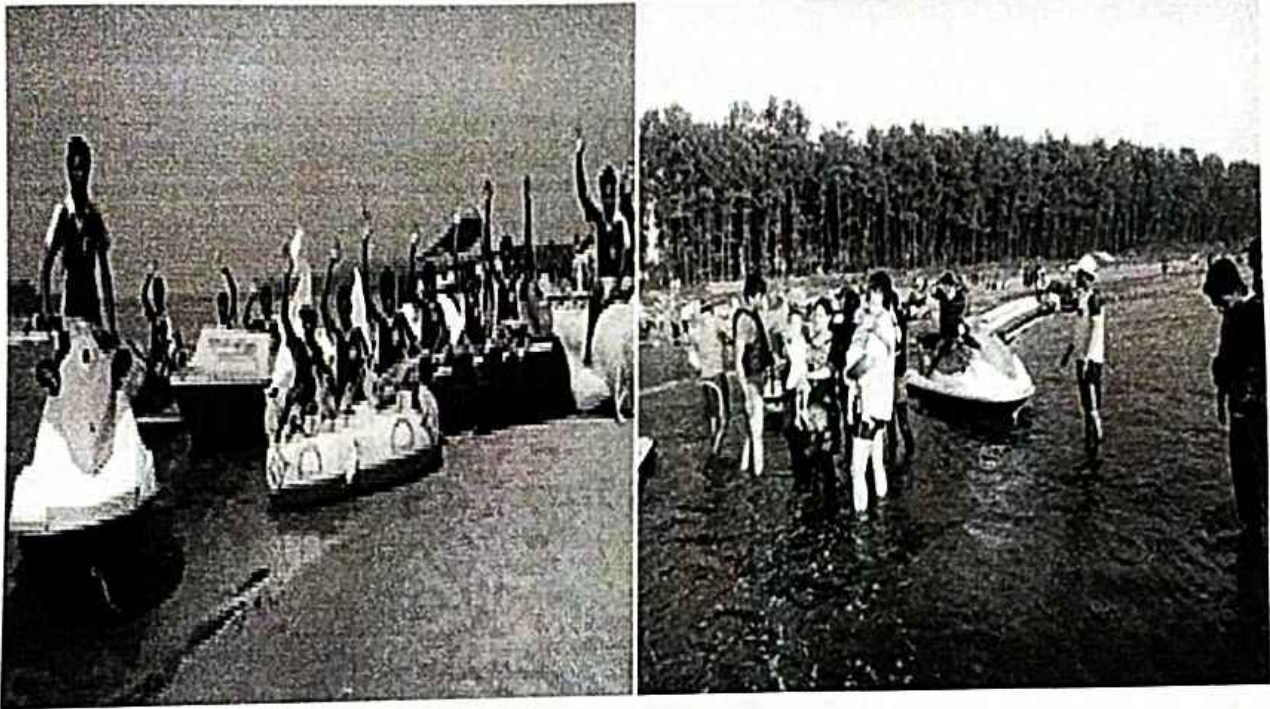
The average height of the fort walls is 25 feet. It has two main entrances, one on the sea side and the other towards alibag. An interesting feature of this fort is that it has freshwater wells in its premises even though it is a seaside fort. In the monsoons, the fort can be reached by wading through waist-deep water at low tide. However, at high tide, boats must be used to reach it. In that fort, there are temples. Many tourists come to visit the kolaba fort. In that fort, there are houses of several people. People stay there and take care of that fort.



Around 3 pm, students were taken to Nagaon beach **Nagaon** is a beach town on the shores of the arabian sea, in the north konkan region of maharashtra, india. It is



located 9 km from alibag and 114 km from mumbai. nagaon beach is popular mainly because of its cleanliness, water sport activities. The beach is around 3 km long where the adventure water sports like banana boats, para gliding, mini cruises etc were used as commercial tourist attraction . All the students were made to take a round in a 12 seater boat and students were shown the condition of coastal areas because of pollution and tourist congestions.



At 5.00 pm, the bus left alibag for returning, on the way , everyone halted at one café center where refreshment took place.

All reached back at college premises at 10.00 pm, and in the end students appreciated the outcomes of the visit.

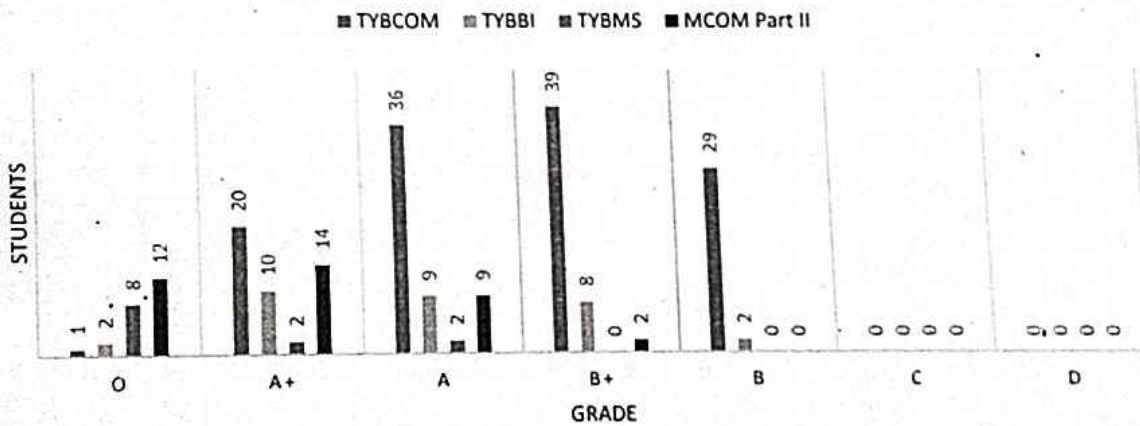

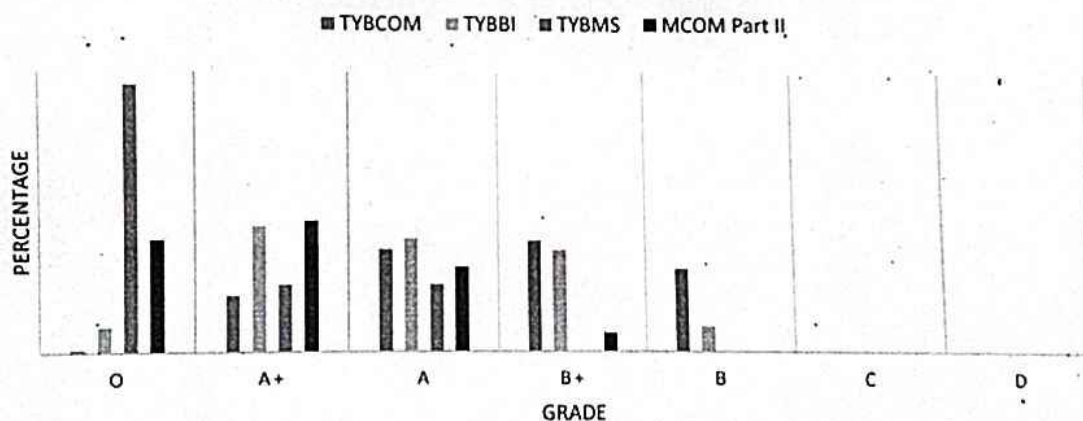
