




The topic was rather controversial and had economic importance. Government budget is used to prevent business fluctuations of inflation or deflation to achieve the objective of economic stability. The government aims to control the different phases of business fluctuations through its budgetary policy.

A Governments' budget is a year-long country's financial report explaining item-wise calculations of future revenue and expenditure. The budget explains what the income and expense of a nation is.

In India, every beginning of a year, the government presents its budget in front of the Lok Sabha explaining an estimated receipt and expense for the upcoming financial year. The fiscal year starts from 1st April and concludes on 31st March of the next year.

The government prepares an expenditure according to its objective and then starts gathering the resources and funds to fulfil the proposed investment. The funds are collected from fees, taxes, interest on loans given to states, fines, and dividends by public sector enterprises.

REPORT ON "ONE-DAY INDUSTRIAL VISIT"

Date:07/03/2019

Venue: Go Cheese Factory

Objective: To learn the production process of cheese from milk diary to

cheese factory.

One day industrial visit was organised on 7th March,2019 by the BMS & BBI Department. Co-ordinator Prof. Ms. SmitaChawak, for BMS &BBI Department students under the guidance of Prof. PranjalKarkhanis, Prof. Sophy Mathew, Prof. Deepa and Prof. Sharmila Karve industrial visit to GO CHEESE FACTORY at Pune, (Manchar amidst Maharashtra's western hills and parag milk diary/food.)

In month of march, we got opportunity of visiting GO CHEESE FACTORY, a good 2hour drive from pune operated from manchar amidst Maharashtra's western hills. This is home diarym farm and cheese factory owned by the one of the pioneers of dairy products in India, Parag milk foods. The brand like Gowardhan, pride of cows and Go Cheese.

The itinerary included to visit the home-grown dairy farm, cheese factory and understand behind the scenes of the manufacturing of the delicious milk products. We started with the Bhagyalaxmi Dairy Farm visit owned by the company where around 3500 and more cows from their birth to handling over to farmers (once their milk production reduces) including sanitation, nutrition, and survival. Thing which intrigued me was the automation at the farm to reduce contamination and avoid spread of communicable aliments. Even the rotary belt used to milch cows is fully automated and at a time can milch up to 35cows. We also tasted the fresh milk that gets packaged in bottles of pride of cows to be delivered at various

locations across and has been recognised as the best packaged milk. Now was the time for cheese factory visit. Started with the dressing for the tour, we were given briefing of the various types of cheese produced and the uses followed by the showcase of various procedures of the manufacturing and packaging.

Most of the process is same except for the time required for ripening of the cheese for different kinds. Mozzarella takes 2-10 days to ripe with extreme cold temperature, cheddar might take quarter to half an year. Post the visit, we were offered the milk and cheese manufactured at the factory. There were varieties of pizza, different flavours, cheese cubes, nachos, cream, etc. made with milk.

So, the amazing experience came to an interesting interactive session with the factory team followed by cheese tasting session. And we did get enough time to "SAY CHEESE".


After that students were taken on field visit to show difference in qualities of various food items. They were even allowed to practically find difference by tasting some of the products.

REPORT ON RESEARCH METHODS:-



Topics covered on HRM are as follows:


- a) Introduction of Human resource.

REPORT-ON GST

Sadhubella Education Society's J.W. Sadhubella Girls College, Commerce Department in association with IQAC organized workshop on GST on 2ndApril, 2018. The main aim of conducting this work shop was to create general awareness regarding GST (Goods & Service Tax). On this occasion college invited CA Mukesh Haseja as resource person. Ms. Hitika Makhijani welcome our speaker and give brief information about his achievements. Then Our Principal Dr. Vasant Mali felicitated to the resource person.

Topics covered on GST are as follows:

Our speaker CA Mukesh Haseja stated in his speech that "GST aims at to replace all indirect levied on goods and services by the Indian Central and State Governments. GST would subsume with a single comprehensive tax, bringing it all under a single umbrella, eliminating the adverse effects of taxes on the production and the distribution prices of goods and services. Imposing several taxes on goods and services can lead to high cost and inefficient tax structure which can subject to shirking and revenue disclosures. The need for GST in Indian Taxation System will add value at each stage and will set off the rates both at state and at central level. Introducing GST, will increase the efficiency of taxation, improves the economic growth and it will bring whole nation to one national market. Our present taxation system is very complex and very confusing, corruption chance is there, which leads to distrust of government, there are hidden tax for exports, whereas no charge applicable on Importing of Goods/Services from one state to another. Just to overcome these issues, Rajya Sabha introduced GST bill, which will bring transparency to taxation and consumer will get to know how much tax amount they are paying to government for sale/ purchase/ manufacturing.

Tax Structure will be Simple: – At present, there are huge number of taxes that has to pay by consumers, with GST it will single tax to pay, which is much easier to understand. For businesses, accounting complexities will reduce and results less paperwork, which will save both time and money.

Tax revenue will increase: Simple tax structure will bring more tax payers and in return it will be revenue for government.

Boost to exports: If Indian market will be competitive in pricing, then more and more foreign players will try to enter the market, which results in more numbers of exporters and benefits to Indian Market.

At the end of the session Asst. Prof. Ms. Hitika Makhijani delivered vote of thanks. There were 77participants attended this workshop.

This workshop covered innovative technologies such as artificial intelligence, Internet of Things (IOT), machine learning, block-chain, big data ,etc. This workshop

highlights new fancy innovations in the technology space.

This workshop covered illustrative "CIO Wishlist" to complement or enable comprehensive digital bank. This workshop gave examples of various technology projects done by CIOs at the front- office, middle-office and back-office to enable comprehensive coverage of digital banking.

77 participants were attended this workshop and could overview of how global banks are transforming their banking from traditional to high digital environment.
