




HP GAS SAFETY MEET REPORT

Ms. Deepa Makhija discussed the objectives of creation of Alumni Association.







Health club chairperson Mrs.SmitaChawak explained the objectives of organising the seminar.




After the session many students asked their doubts and discussed their health problem related to menstruation with the DrSushmaTomar.

Report on "How to manage money and be a smart investor"






Mrs. Kajal Bhojwani discussed extensively from top to bottom on the importance of excommerce. She expressed that e-commerce is known as electronic commerce or internet commerce, refers to buying and selling of goods or services using the internet. It is often used to refer to the sale of physical products online but it can also describe any kind of commercial transaction, that is facilitated through the internet. There are four main types of e-commerce models: business of consumers, business to business, consumers to consumers and consumer to business.

E-commerce can take on a variety of forms involving different transactional relationships. Retail, whole sale, drop shipping, crowd funding subscribes on physical product, digital products, services are various form of e commerce. Modern electronic commerce typically uses the world wide web. It uses other technology such as e-mail. E-commerce transaction include the purchase of online books and music purchases etc. E-commerce business also employ online shopping for retail sales direct to consumers providing in online market places.

Global trends of online business are increasing rapidly. Among emerging economies, china's e-commerce presents continues to expand every year. The Chinese retailers have been able to help consumers retail sales in that period. E-commerce has been an important tool for small and large business worldwide. Not only to sell to customer but also to engage them. Mobile

devices are playing an increasing role in the mix of e- commerce. This is also called mobile commerce.

Dr. Bhojwani stated the importance of logistics in E-commerce. Online markets and retailers have found the best possible way to fill orders and deliver products. Small companies usually control their own logistic operation but most large companies hire fulfillment services that takes care of company's logistic needs.
