

The whole world is affected by the COVID-19 pandemic. Most of the countries have declared lockdown for more than 40 days. People are forced to work from home. Use of internet, e-communication platforms are at a peak everywhere. In this situation it would be interesting to know how library professionals around the world are coping with this situation, what innovative services they are providing to the virtual community, and what is their view on future Library services and the LIS job market

This FDP will try to highlight how libraries are coping in the COVID-19 pandemic. It will be useful for LIS teachers, librarians and academic community to know how the situation is handled around the world.

Necessary Development Programme

Education, knowledge, information, and learning are important facets of academic institutions. The advancement of information and communication technology in the curriculum of academics has brought significant change not only in the library and information services but also in the changing roles and expectations from the librarians and information professionals. Customer-focused and user-oriented approach has replaced the traditional librarianship which requires specialized subject knowledge and skills. It implies that either by compulsion or willingly, continuing learning is the need of the day for the library and information professionals.

Objectives of Librarian Development Programme

- To equip librarians with new skills and knowledge of the nascent IT developments that are essential for providing better library services to the users.
- To maintain and enhance library effectiveness;
- To help librarians to fulfill academic responsibilities;
- To create research and collaborative network between LISc professionals; and
- To help the participants in understanding the IT discipline for merging the library science and hube IT knowledge for the better functioning of libraries.

SNDT Women's University

SNDT Women' University is the first Women's University in India as well as in South-East Asia. The University

was founded by Maharshi Dr. Dhondo Keshav Karve in 1916 for a noble cause of Women's Education. The first five women graduated in 1921 from this University. The University Headquarters is in Churchgate Campus, Mumbai and the other two campuses of this University are at Juhu, Mumbai and Karve Road, Pune.

BMK KRC, SNDTWU

Bharatratana Maharshi Karve Knowledge Resource Centre (KRC) (formerly Library) ,SNDT Women's University, is a multi-unit library system with a Central library and two Branch libraries. The Central library at Churchgate Mumbai was founded in 1955 with a small collection 3000 volumes, the Pune Branch Library was founded in 1964, and the Juhu Branch library was founded in 1968. Today the library has grown into a system with more than 4 lakh volumes and several user oriented services. The KRC system caters to the needs of the university's conducted colleges and departments The mission of the KRC is to support the teaching, research and extension activities of the university by providing to students, faculty and staff, information and documentary resources and services, relevant to their needs. Being an integral part of the university, the KRC is committed to play a proactive role in the empowerment of women through dissemination and use of information and knowledge (sndt.ac.in).

SHPT School of Library Science, SNDTWU

The School since its foundation in 1961 has empowered more than 2000 women library professionals employed in India and globally in different types of libraries. M.L.I.Sc. and Ph.D. courses offered at the School focus on the latest trends in LIS field. ICT based curriculum enhances students' capacity to work in today's digital era. With the COVID-19 pandemic the School has conducted online classes and used Learning Management System Moodle for the benefit of students.

J. Watumall Sadhubela Girls College

J.Watumull Sadhubella Girls College started its pious journey with the blessings of AcharyaSwami Ganeshdashji Maharaj, the founder of Sadhubella Education Society. He believes that "The need of the time is to nourish the students for all-round personality development much beyond academic excellence. The weaker female section has been neglected by the Indian Society since centuries." The kind heart of Swamiji inspired him to start the educational institute exclusively for girls on a piece of land measuring two acres in the congested city

of Ulhasnagar. This college made a humble beginning in the academic year 1994 with only 38 students, a single department. It is the only girl's college in the Mumbai Central suburban area which includes Thane, Kalyan, Ulhasnagar, Ambernath, Dombivali, Bhivandi, Murbad and Shahapur talukas. Though initially it was on non-grant basis, since 1998-99 the B.Com programme came under Grant-in-Aid.

Mumbai University and College Teachers Association (MUCTA)

Mumbai University and College Teachers Association (MUCTA) was established in the year 2008 and is registered under Society Registration Act. Since three members were elected as the authority members it became easy for MUCTA to raise issues for safeguarding teachers' interests like timely salary payment, allowances, service conditions, work load, examination remuneration, approvals, CAS, syllabus revision on regular intervals etc.



The session started with National Anthem of India and SNDT Women's University Song. Followed by that Dr. Parul Zaveri briefly introduced SNDT Women's University, Bharat Ratna Maharshi Karve Knowledge Resource Centre, SHPT School of Library Science, and J. Watumall



Sadhubella Girls College. Dr. Minaxi introduced Mumbai University College Teachers' Association. After this Dr. Parul Zaveri introduced the speaker Mr. Prashant Pandey

Mr. Prashant Pandey's talk was divided into three areas namely environmental condition in higher education leading to demand for change, Transformational ways libraries can respond to this demand and case study of how Flinders University Library is responding to current situation.

His talk focused on how the higher education system is changing globally, types of funding coming to higher education in different countries. He also emphasized on an open school concept and commented on the employment situation in general.

Mr Pandey said that there were challenges for the library professionals to be creative and provide library services while going from print to digital transformation and in automating libraries. He also talked about going from generalized LIS skills to specific skills required in librarianship, for e.g. data analytics, communication experts, blended librarianship and thus getting trained with the right skills for the right job.

Dr Pandey also mentioned that there will be disrupters in every profession including LIS, but LIS professionals should take these as challenges and turn them into opportunities. Libraries should be user centered and provide customized services. He also talked about how the Flinders University is coping up with the COVID- 19 pandemic and started offering education in online mode. His talk focused on what actions the library has taken like putting up signages for safe distancing in the library at multiple locations. Another service provided by the library is 'Book a librarian' where they can have dialog with the librarian. In the current situation there is an increased demand for the Book a librarian service compared to last year in 2019. He also mentioned about creating a road map of what to do once libraries become onsite. Key-takeaway from his talk is that LIS Professionals have to accept changing demand in current COVID-19 pandemic and reach users wherever they are by providing services in an online mode.

The talk was followed by a question answer session conducted by Ms. Jayshree Kamble. Followed by a vote of thanks.





Most of these being free, can be accessed without any restrictions at the user end.

Mr.Zakir explained the use of open access resources and spoke about specific skills required in searching open access resources for e.g. Emerald Database is a closed access database but if anyone wants a particular paper, he or she can get it through Authors Website or Research gate. He also mentioned that there will be need to take care of Copyright Issue as well as fair use. He also showed how organizations can make their own websites and also how much data has been curated by organizations and even by governments.

The talk was followed by question answer session conducted by Ms. Varsha Varma and Dr. Dattatraya Kalbande. Vote of thanks was given by Ms. Varsha Varma. The Session was successful as more than 3000 views were seen on YouTube channel. The session was live on Zoom as well as on YouTube Channel.




