- D) Prof. Sonam Kotwani







Resource Person Mr. Tushar Mahajan and Mrs. Darshana Mishra was invited for they session



Dr. Sandesh Wagh introduced the chief guest of this conference and give brief ideas about our guest achievements and awards received him then our Honorable Principal Dr. Vasant Mali said aims and objectives of this conference he said This conference provide opportunities for academicians from a range of disciplines and countries to share their research both through the conference podium, provide opportunities for academics to receive informal in-depth feedback through discussions and to enable them to establish contact with professionals in other countries and institutions. It develops relationship among research and their innovations in academic and industrial environment. To develop innovative ideas, new ways and respect among academicians and researcher in healthy atmosphere. To facilitate opportunities for students & academicians to gain experience in business setting and R & D. and correlate religious philosophy with scientific values to strengthen the humanities and maintain harmony in the world.

Dr.P.C.Mankondi Stated in his speech that Taxonomy Of Anthozoans (Phylum: Cnidaria): Trends And Challenges that "Cnidarians contain specialized cells known as enidocytes ("stinging cells"), which contain organelles called nematocysts (stingers). These cells are present around the mouth and tentacles, serving to immobilize prey with toxins contained within the cells. Nematocysts contain coiled threads that may bear barbs. The outer wall of the cell has hairlike projections called enidocils, which are sensitive to touch. When touched, the cells are known to fire coiled threads that can either penetrate the flesh of the prey or predators of enidarians, or ensnare it. These coiled threads release toxins into the target that can often immobilize prey or scare away predators"

Dr.Sandesh Wagh has stated in his speech that "The Annihilation of Caste' was originally a speech prepared by Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar to deliver at a conference of Jat-Pat-Todak Mandal of Lahore in 1936. The Indian Social system for thousands of years observed and maintained Chaturvarnya, Caste, Untouchabilty, and Bonded Labour system. Caste system was based on the principle of negation of democratic principles it generated theory of social and racial discrimination of defeated non Aryans .The Hindu society was divided into thousands of castes which were based on the principle of birth".

Dr. Varsha Zade stated "Evaluation of Indigenous herbal remedies used by tribal's of Melghat region of Amravati district for regulation of Aphrodisiac activity was done. Total six plants used in traditional health care practices by the tribal's were validated scientifically for their aphrodisiac property. Plant



extracts at doses of 100,200,and 400 mg were administered for 21 days to male albino rats .Their general mating behavior, libido and potency along with orientation behavior were studied".

Mr.Patel.S.I. stated that "On Aero mycology Over Some Onion Diseases Under The Storage Conditions" The air borne fungal diseases of onion bulbs during storage conditions like Black mold (Aspergillus niger), Neck rot of onion bulb (Botrytis Alli) and onion basal rot (Fusarium oxysorium) were discussed in relation to the concentration of respective causal pathogen and the meteorological conditions like temperature, humidity and rainfall.

Dr.Shamim Ahmed expressed their view that Climate change is one of the most important global environmental challenges and the many types of impacts are needed to be understood and assessed, vulnerabilities needed to be addressed, while adaptation strategies have to be developed. The Himalayan ecosystem not only provides mountain goods and services but also biodiversity, community diversity and cultural diversity.

Hon'ble Prof. Rajan Santoo,University of Mauritius started his speech he said "Science and technology are essential ingredients of modern life. They transcend local boundaries and touches lives of everyone. Evolution of mankind can be seen in terms of technological evolution as well. Invention of fire and wheel changed the face of mankind. Various historical epochs - hunter-gatherers, agrarian society and industrialist society are distinguished from each other in term of technological advancement. The technological factors represent the conditions created by men that have a profound influence on his life. Technology is product of civilization. 




This type of research is useful in the exploration of how or why things have occurred, interpreting events and describing actions. 
Topics covered on HRM are as follows:

Topics covered on GST are as follows:

Our speaker CA Mukesh Haseja stated in his speech that "GST aims at to replace all indirect levied on goods and services by the Indian Central and State Governments. GST would subsume with a single comprehensive tax, bringing it all under a single umbrella, eliminating the adverse effects of taxes on the production and the distribution prices of goods and Imposing several taxes on goods and services can lead to high cost and inefficient services. tax structure which can subject to shirking and revenue disclosures. The need for GST in Indian Taxation System will add value at each stage and will set off the rates both at state and at central level. Introducing GST, will increase the efficiency of taxation, improves the economic growth and it will bring whole nation to one national market. Our present taxation system is very complex and very confusing, corruption chance is there, which leads to distrust of government, there are hidden tax for exports, whereas no charge applicable on Importing of Goods/Services from one state to another. Just to overcome these issues, Rajya Sabha introduced GST bill, which will bring transparency to taxation and consumer will get to know how much tax amount they are paying to government for sale/ purchase/ manufacturing.

Tax Structure will be Simple: – At present, there are huge number of taxes that has to pay by consumers, with GST it will single tax to pay, which is much easier to understand. For businesses, accounting complexities will reduce and results less paperwork, which will save both time and money.

Tax revenue will increase: Simple tax structure will bring more tax payers and in return it will be revenue for government.

Boost to exports: If Indian market will be competitive in pricing, then more and more foreign players will try to enter the market, which results in more numbers of exporters and benefits to Indian Market.

At the end of the session Asst. Prof. Ms. Hitika Makhijani delivered vote of thanks. There were 77participants attended this workshop.

 Proliferation of internet banking, mobile banking and "direct banking or mobile-only banking or internet-only banking" concept.




regular exercise, plenty of sleep and avoidance alcohol and drugs, care of your emotional health are the best ways to combat with corona.








Dr. Vasant P. Mali delivering the speech during the session on Zumba Fitness on 14/06/2020


