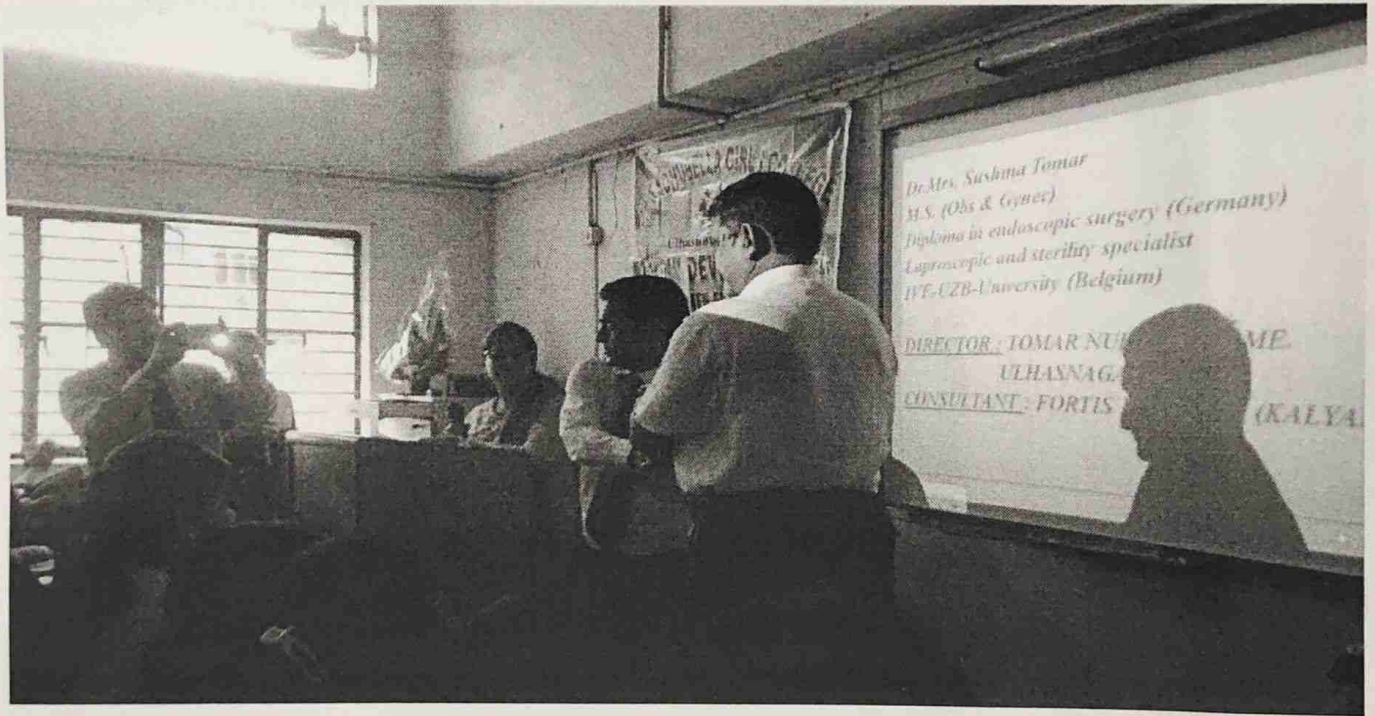

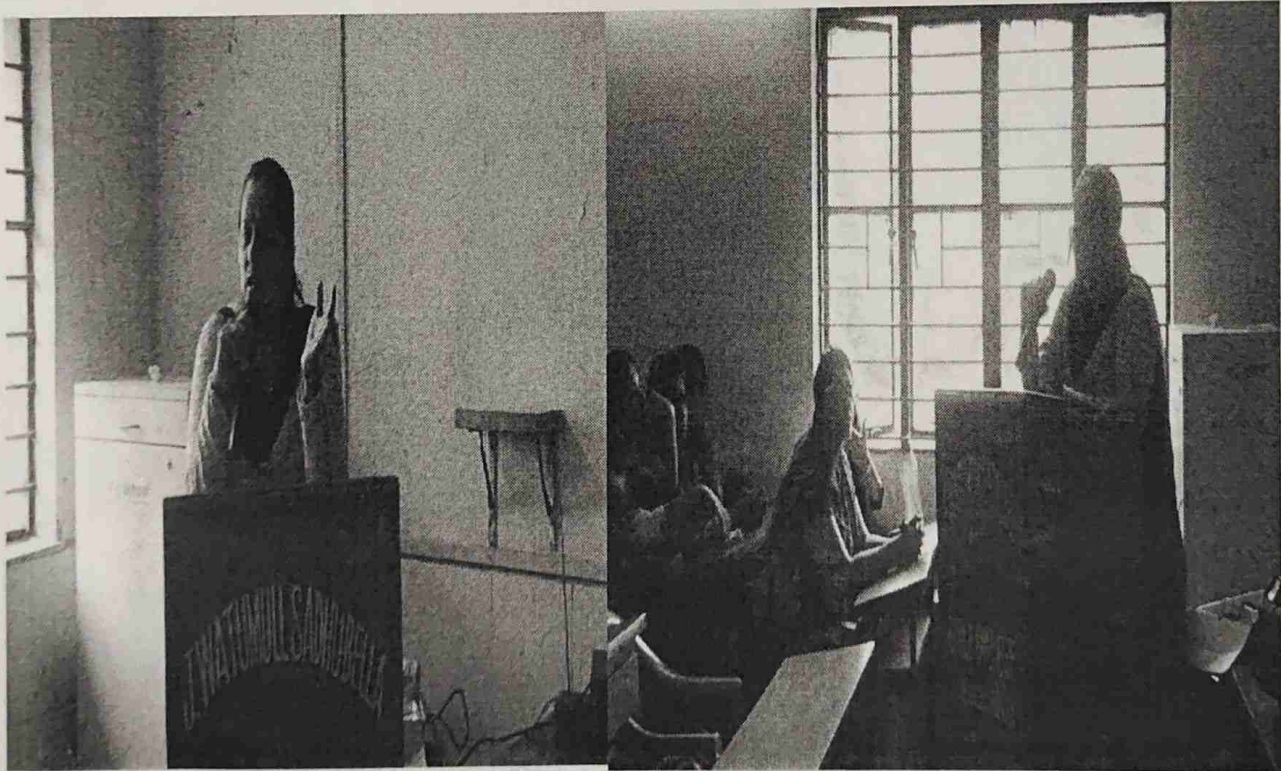


## Session on "Legal Rights of Women"

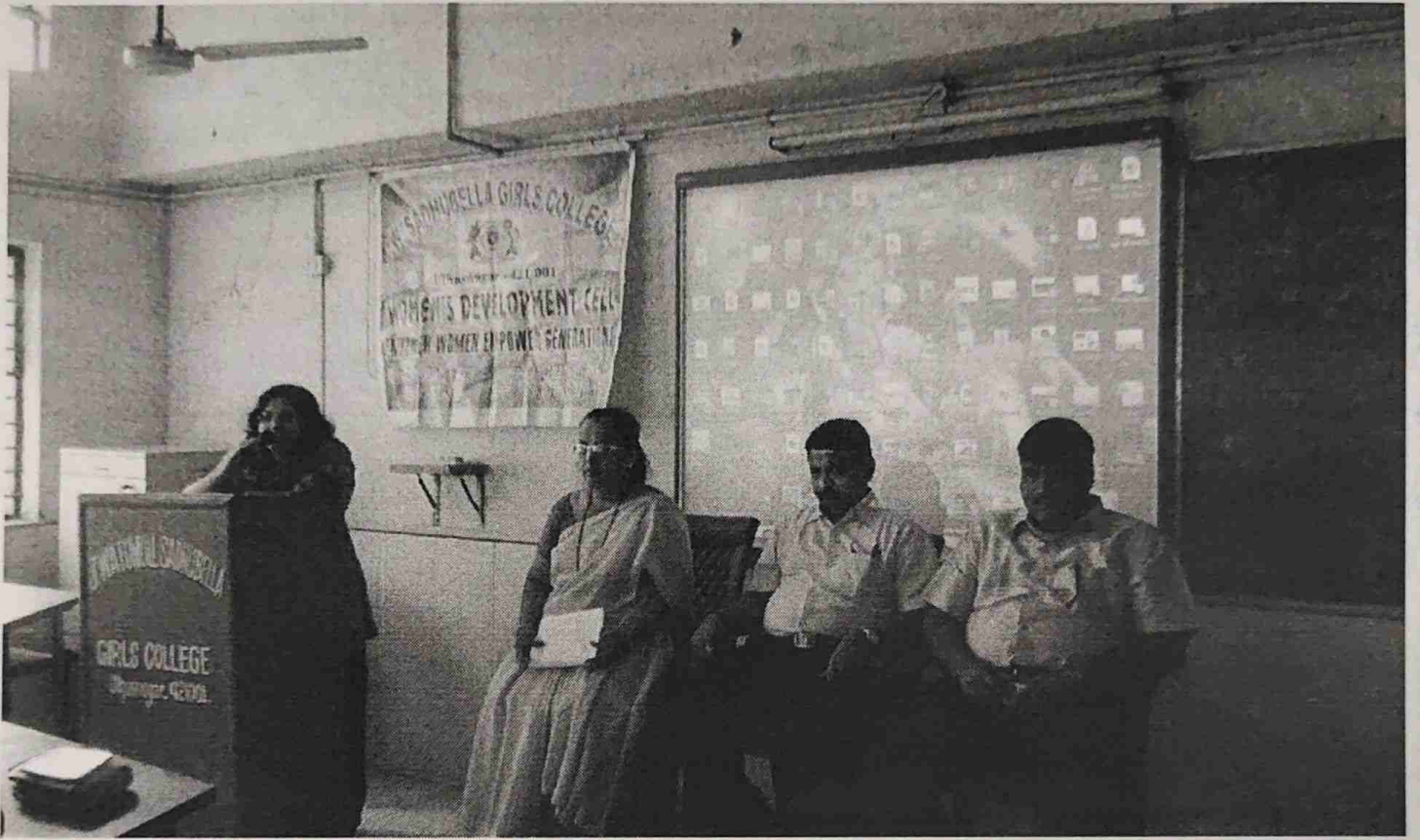

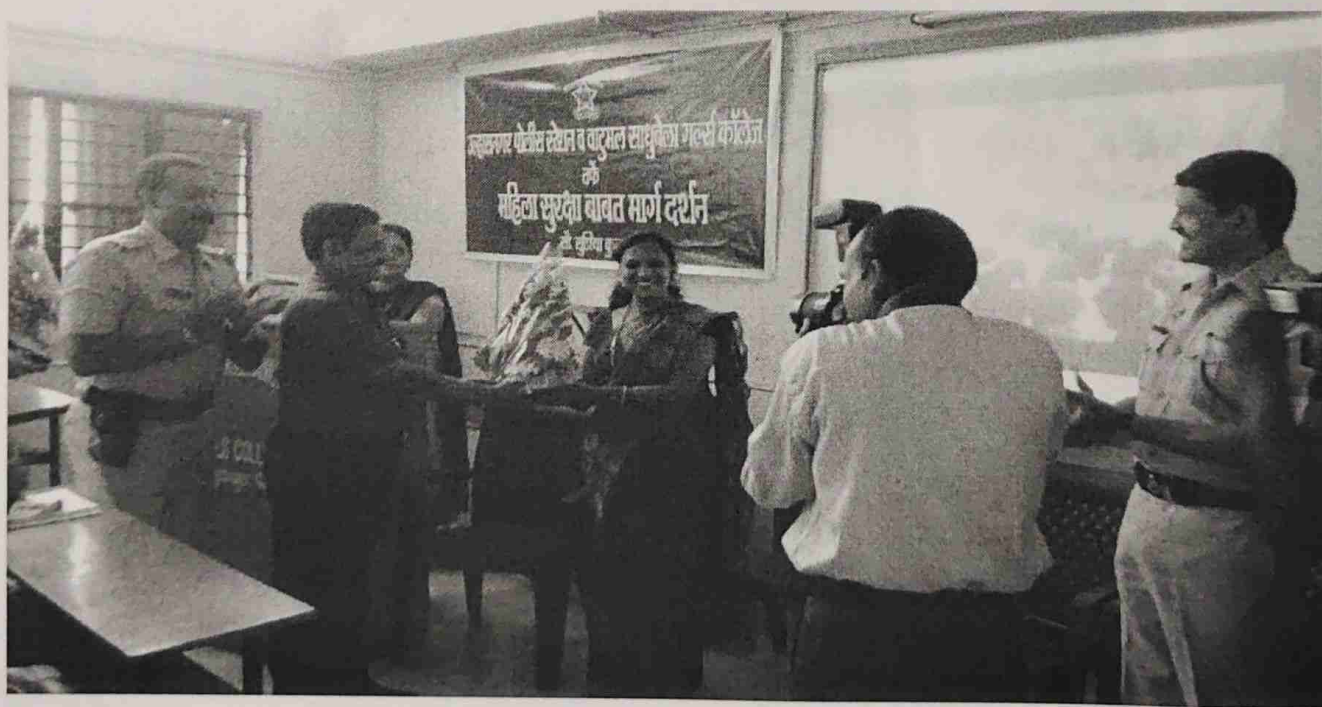


## Session on "Self Defence"

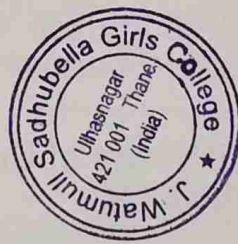

## Session on "Skin Related Diseases"

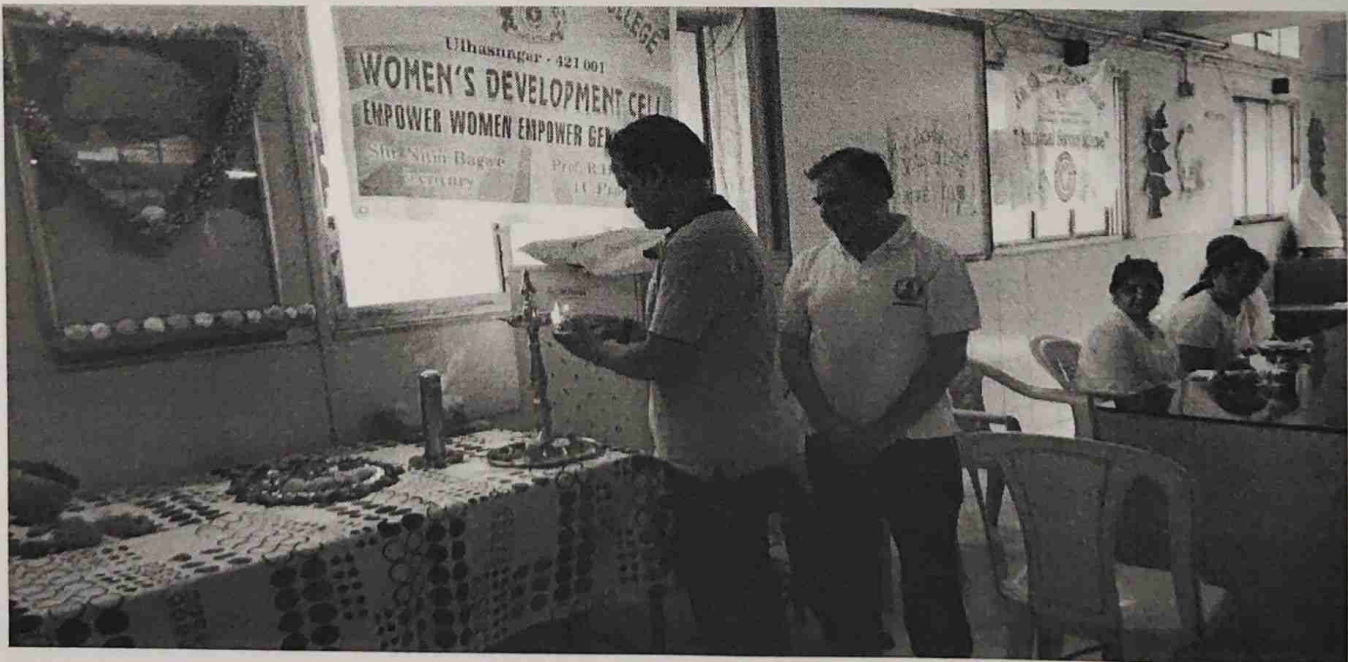

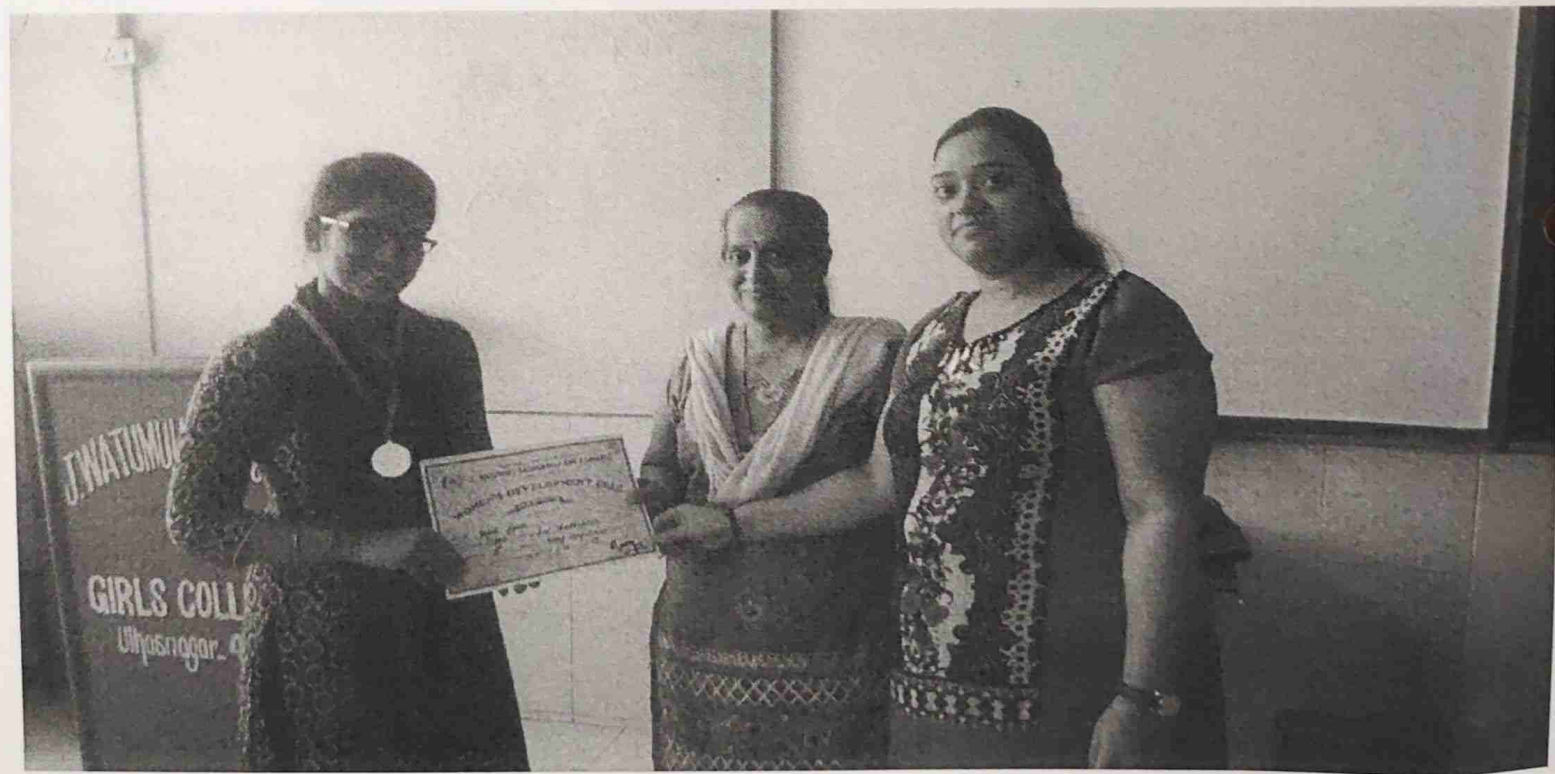

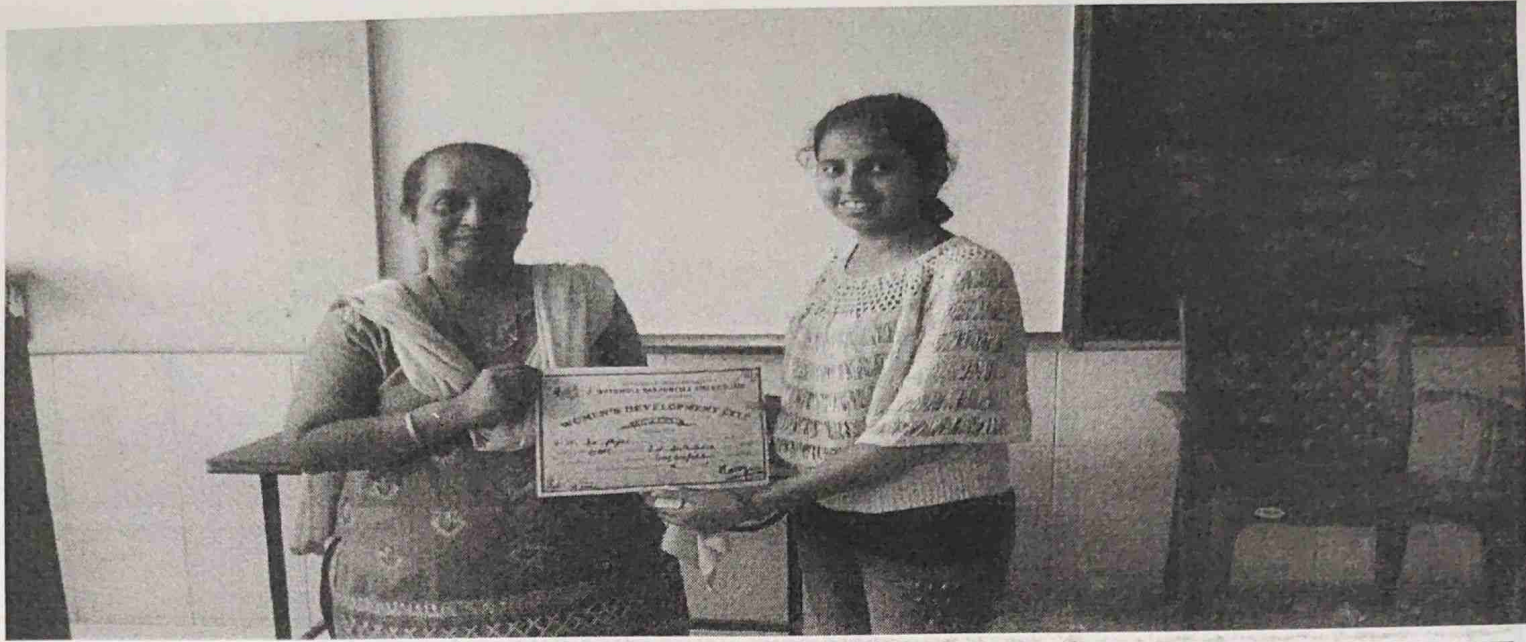

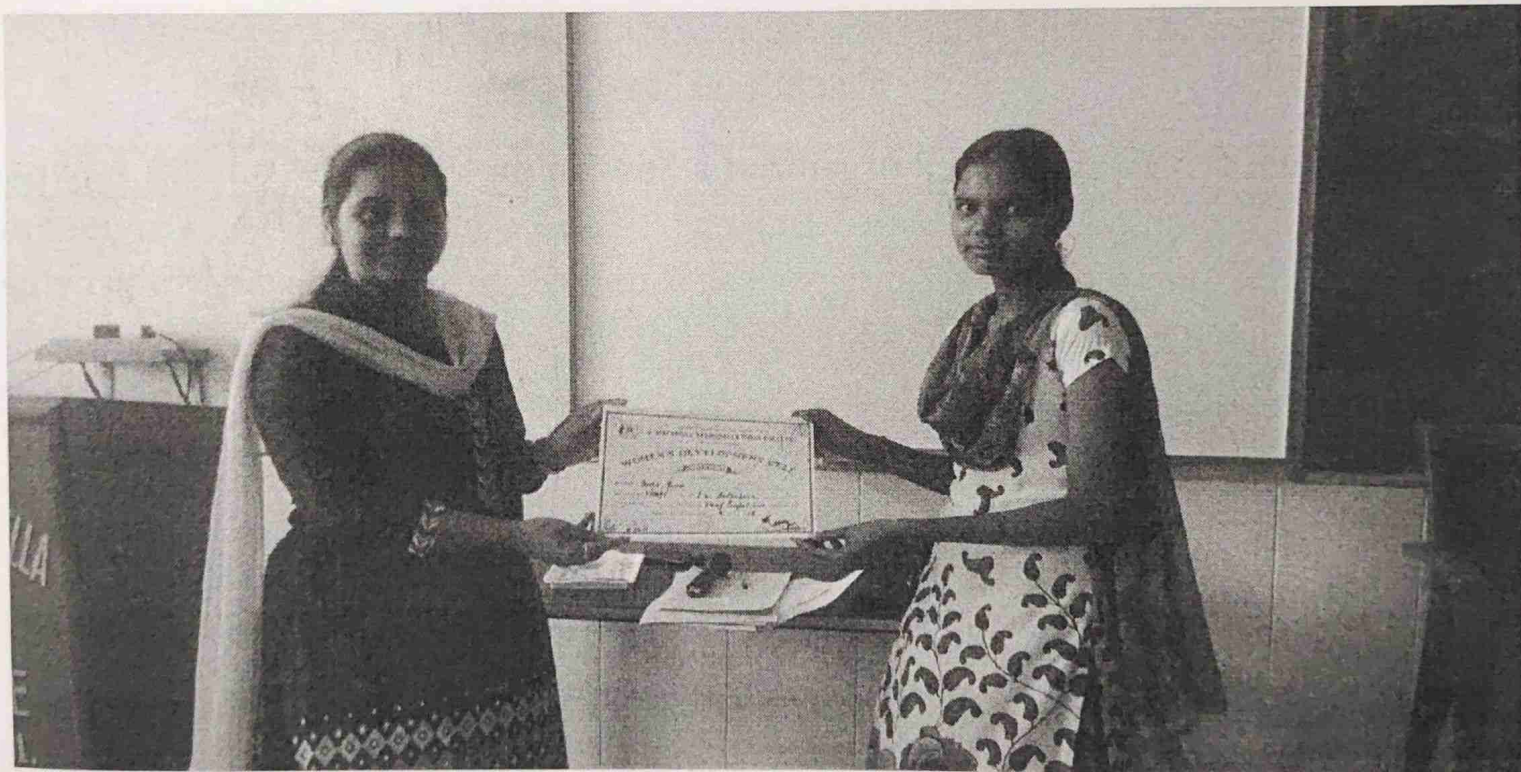

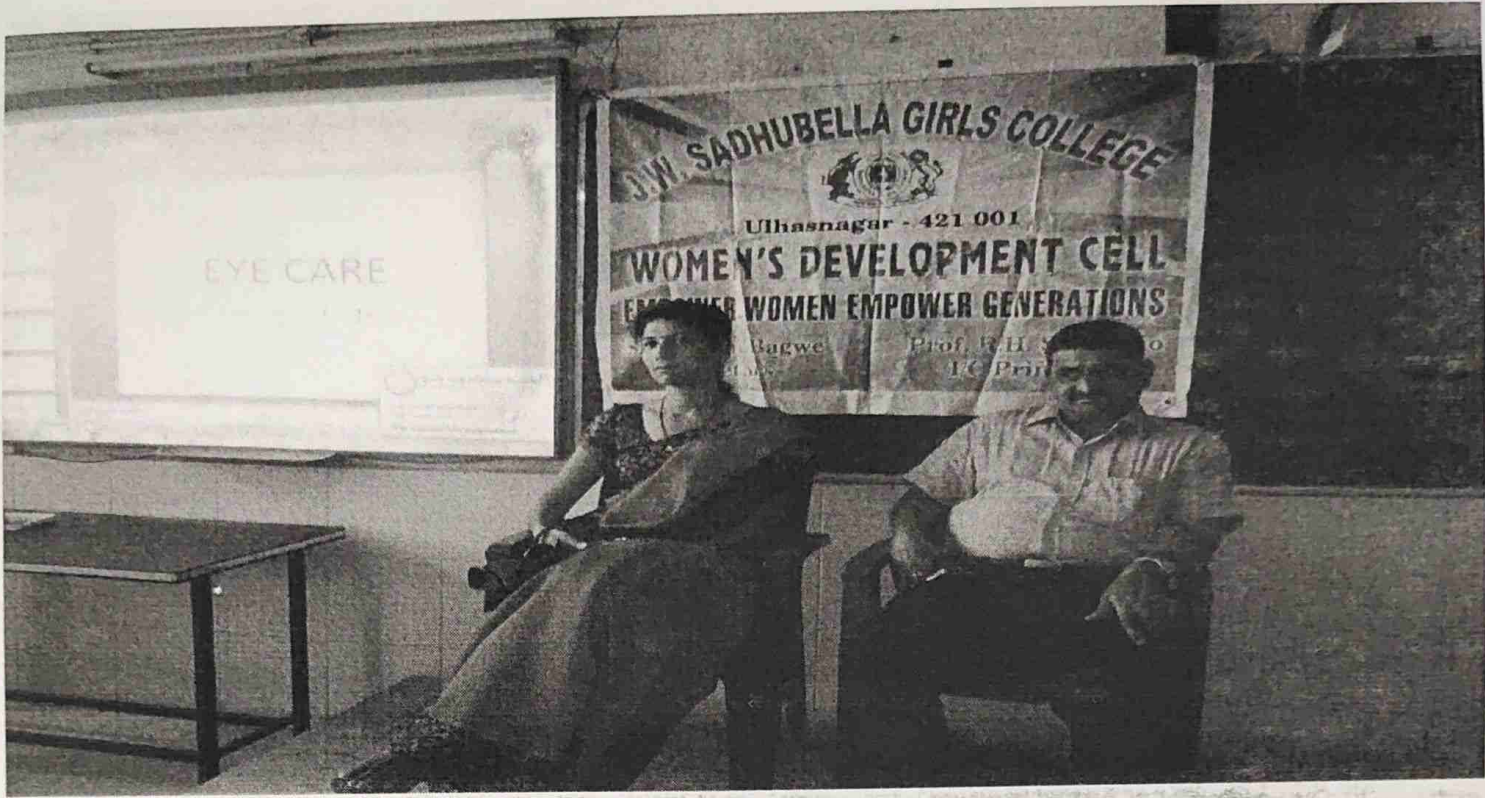
### Session on "Eye Care"

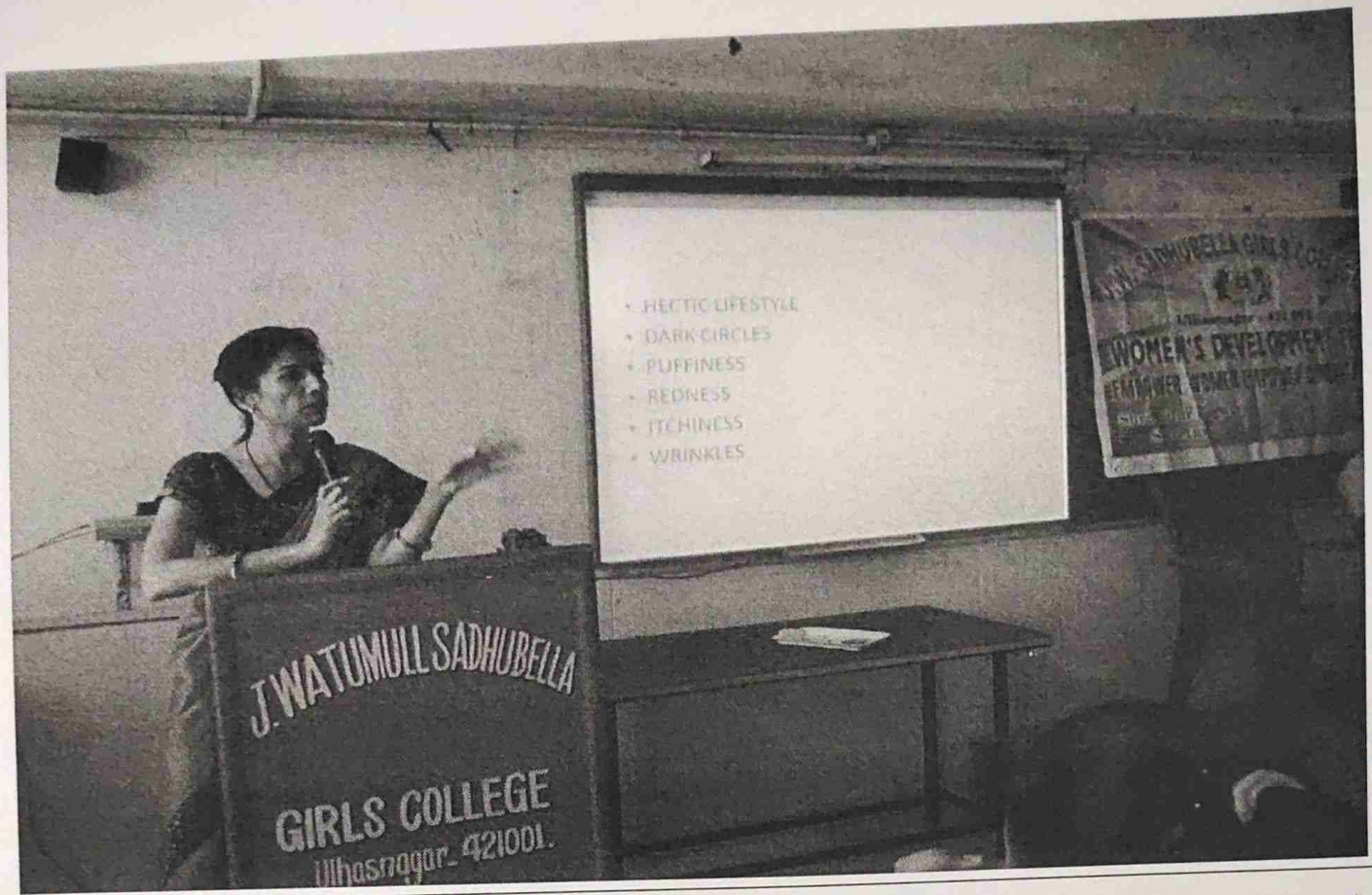

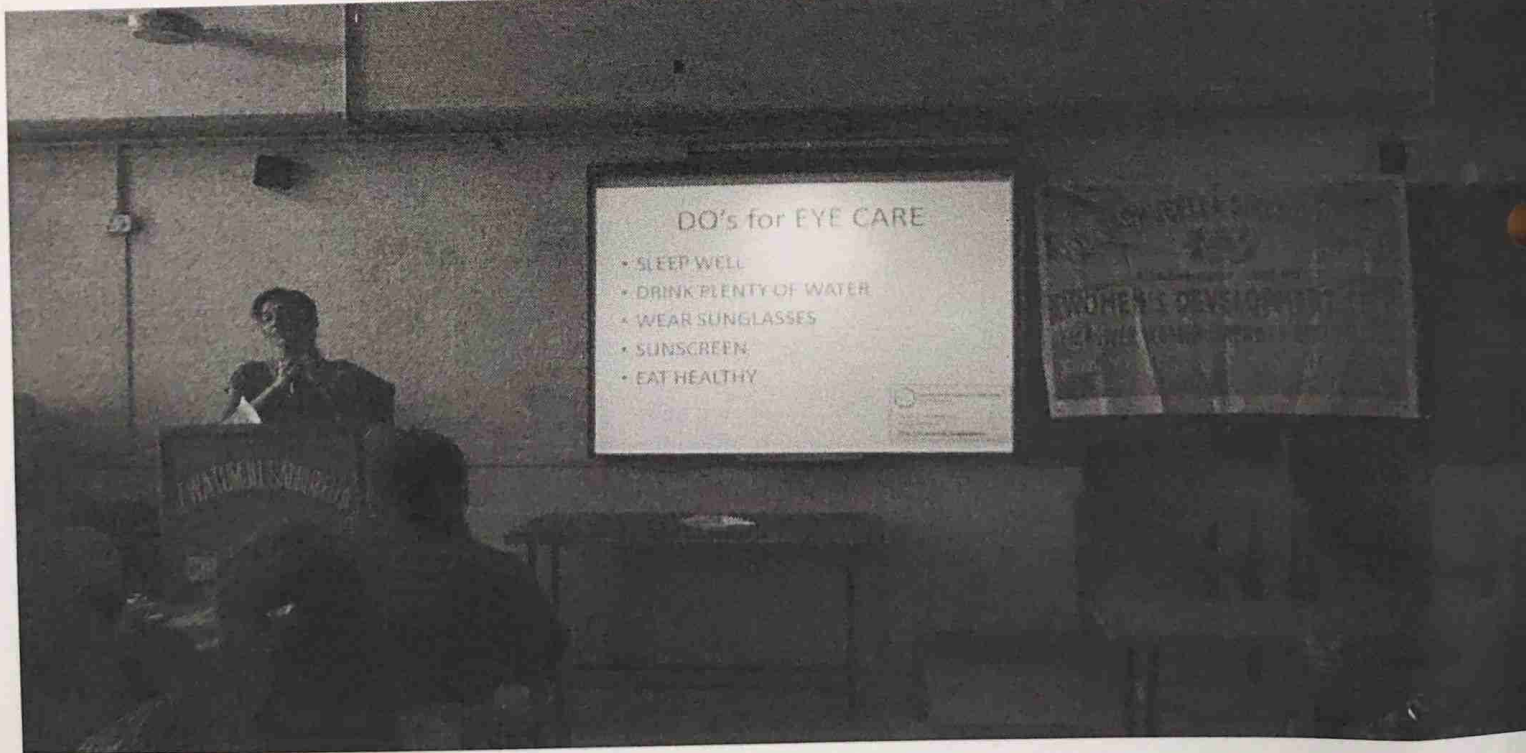

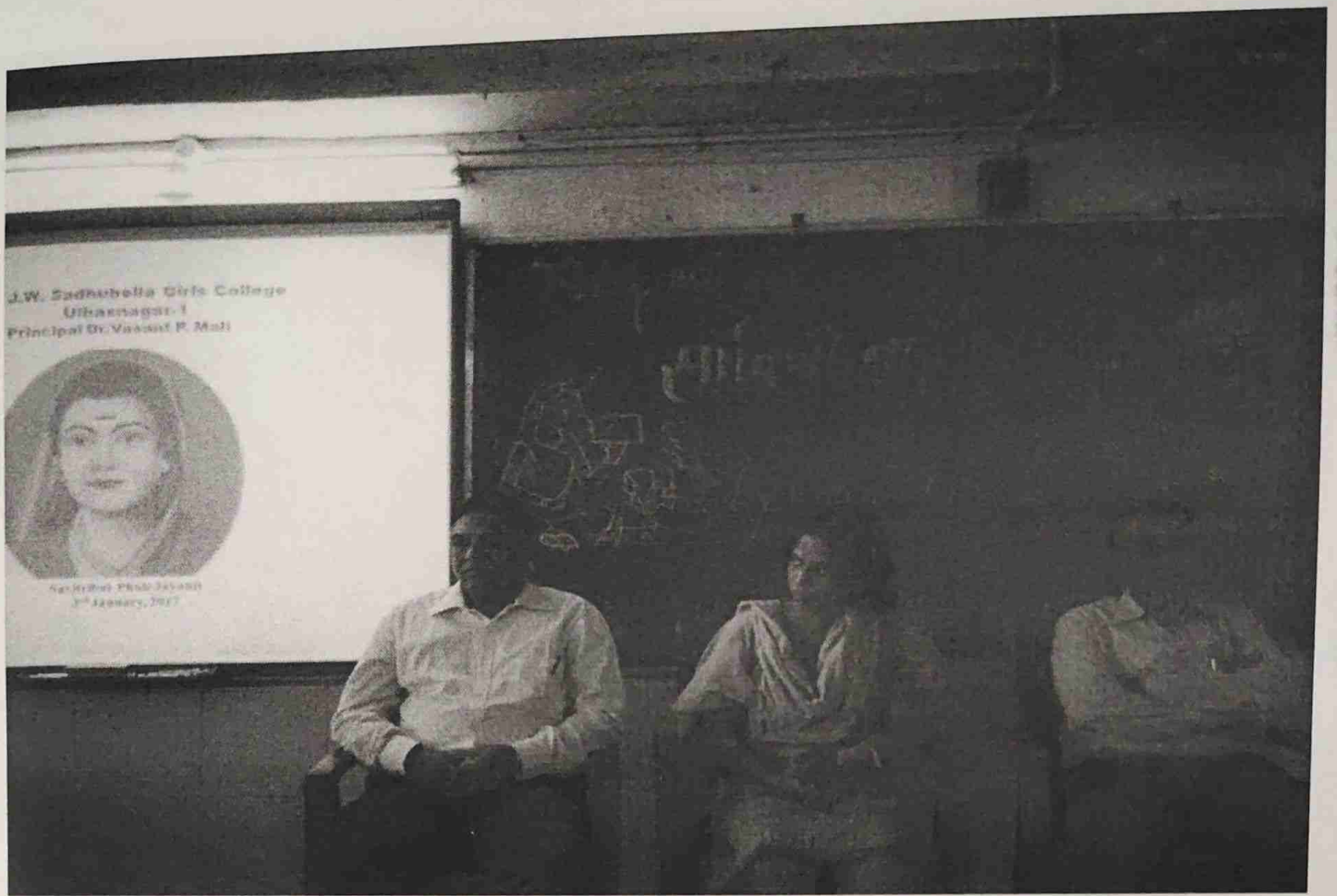

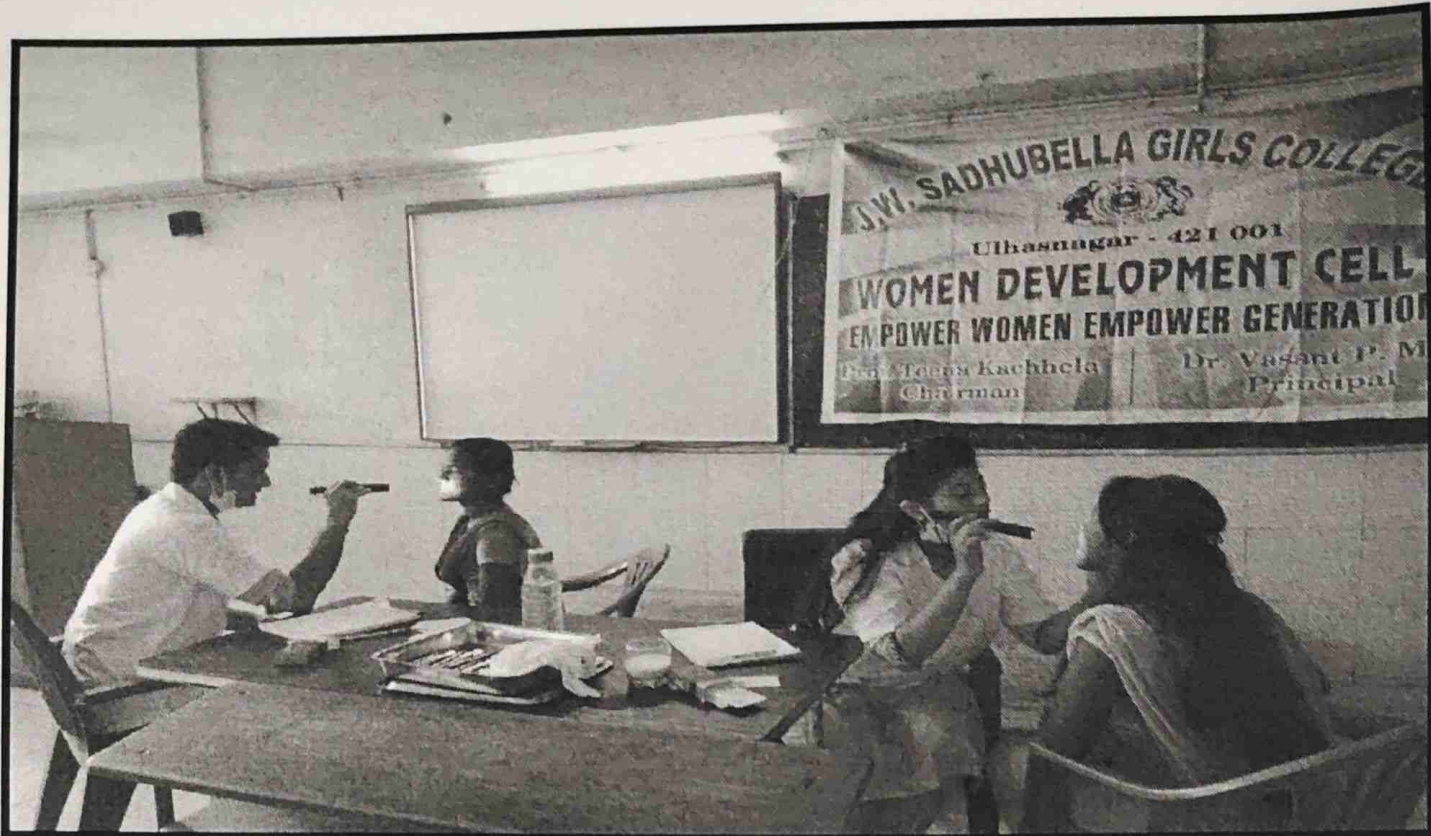
### **Dental Check-up Camp**

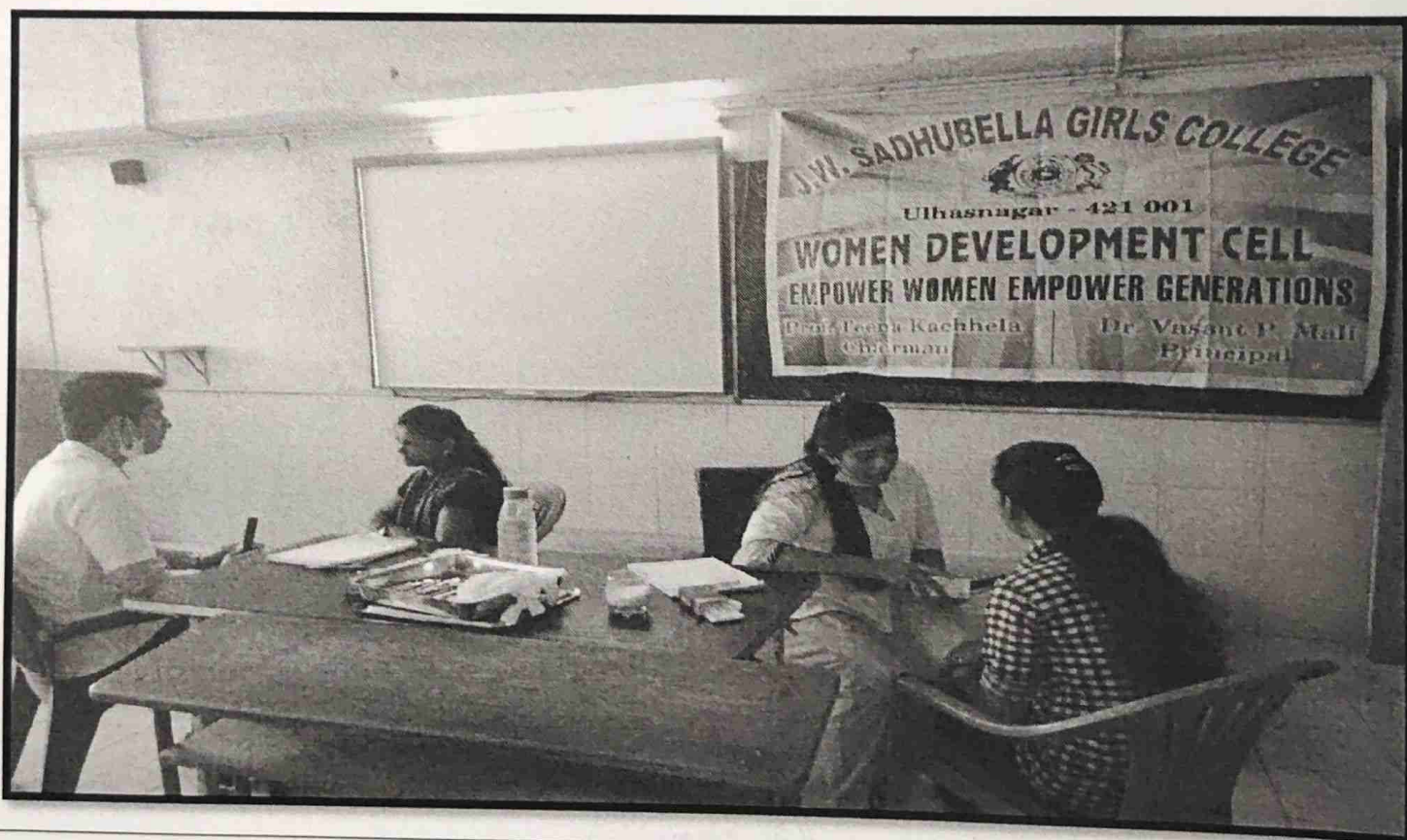

In collaboration with Police Department, our college students also attended a Rally on Road Safety at Goal Maidan with the faculty members.

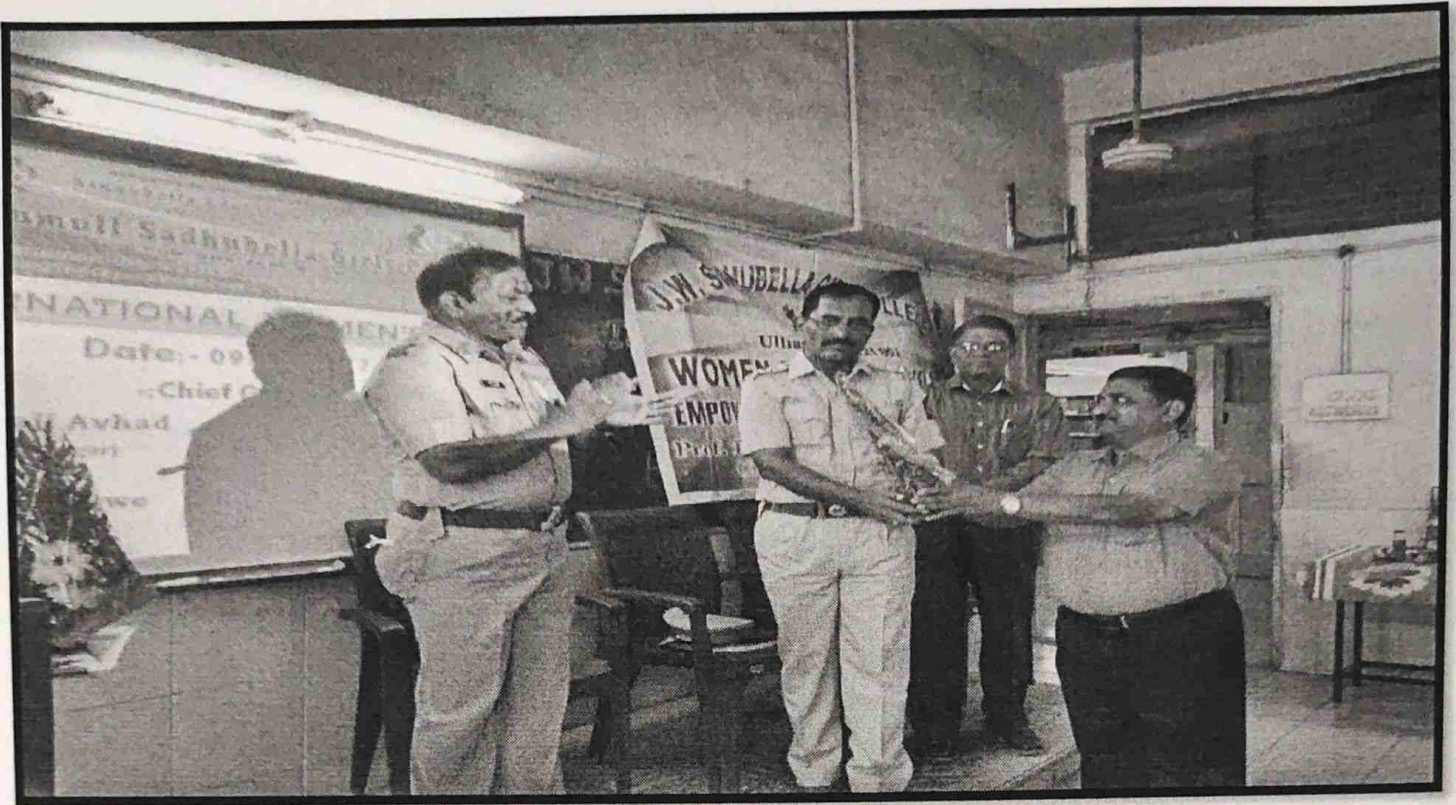

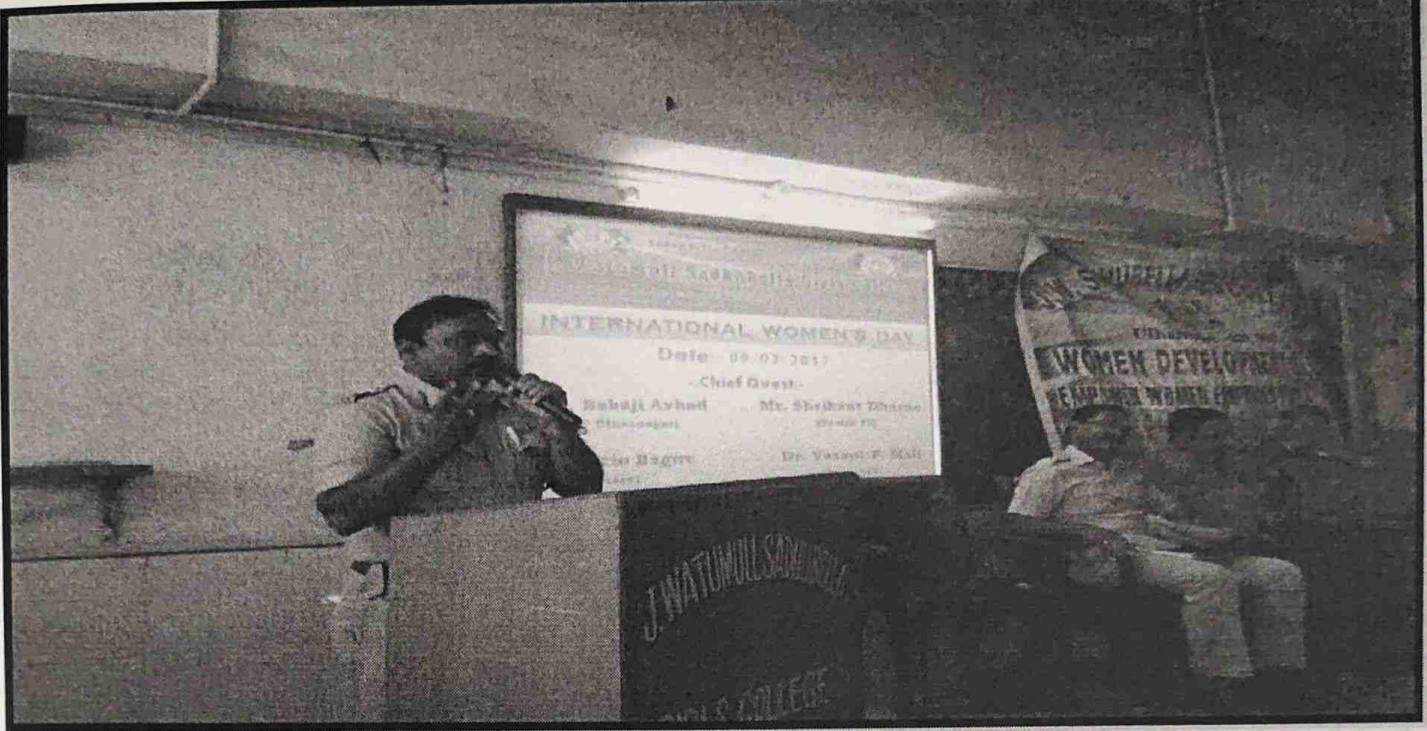

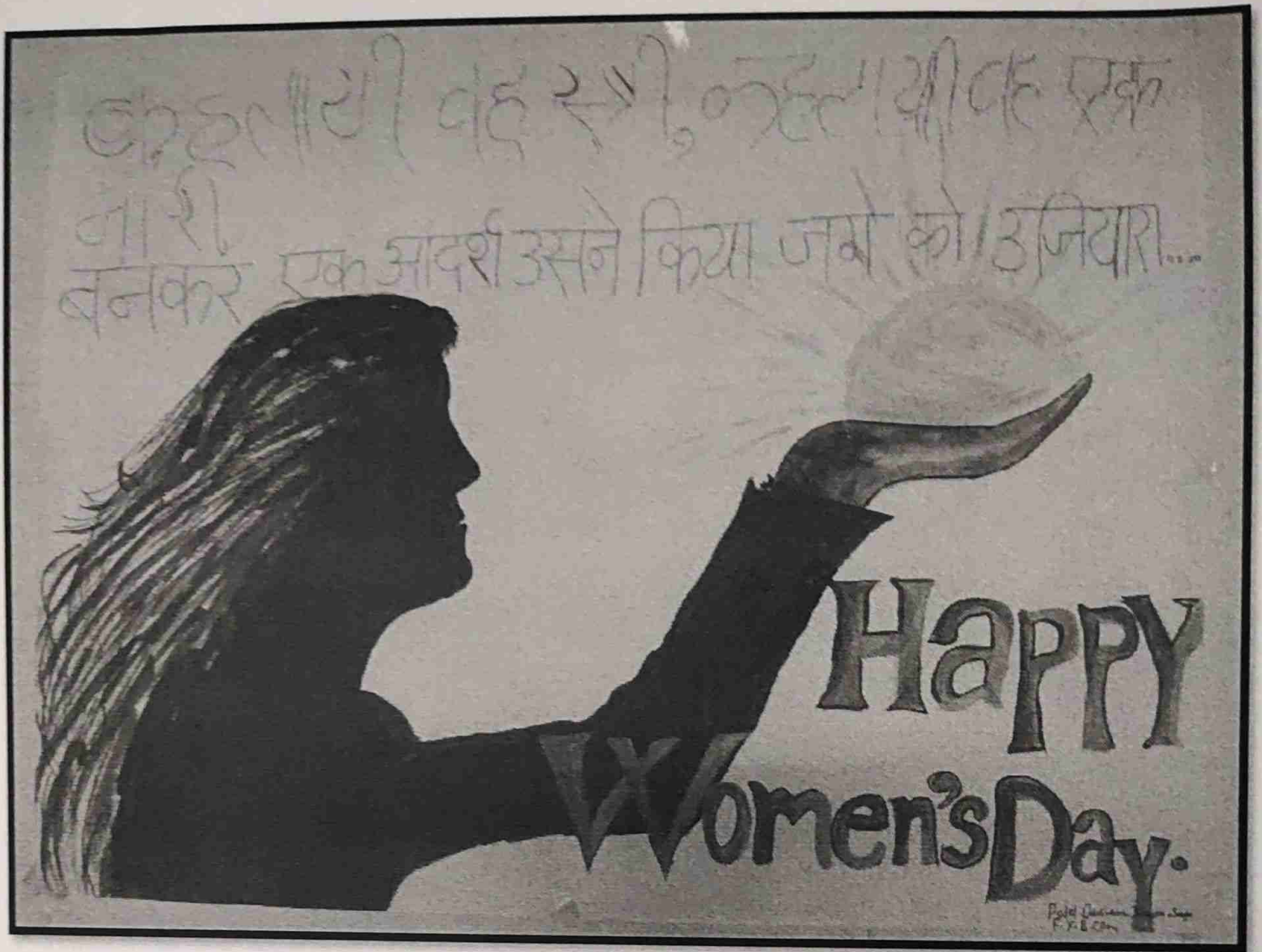

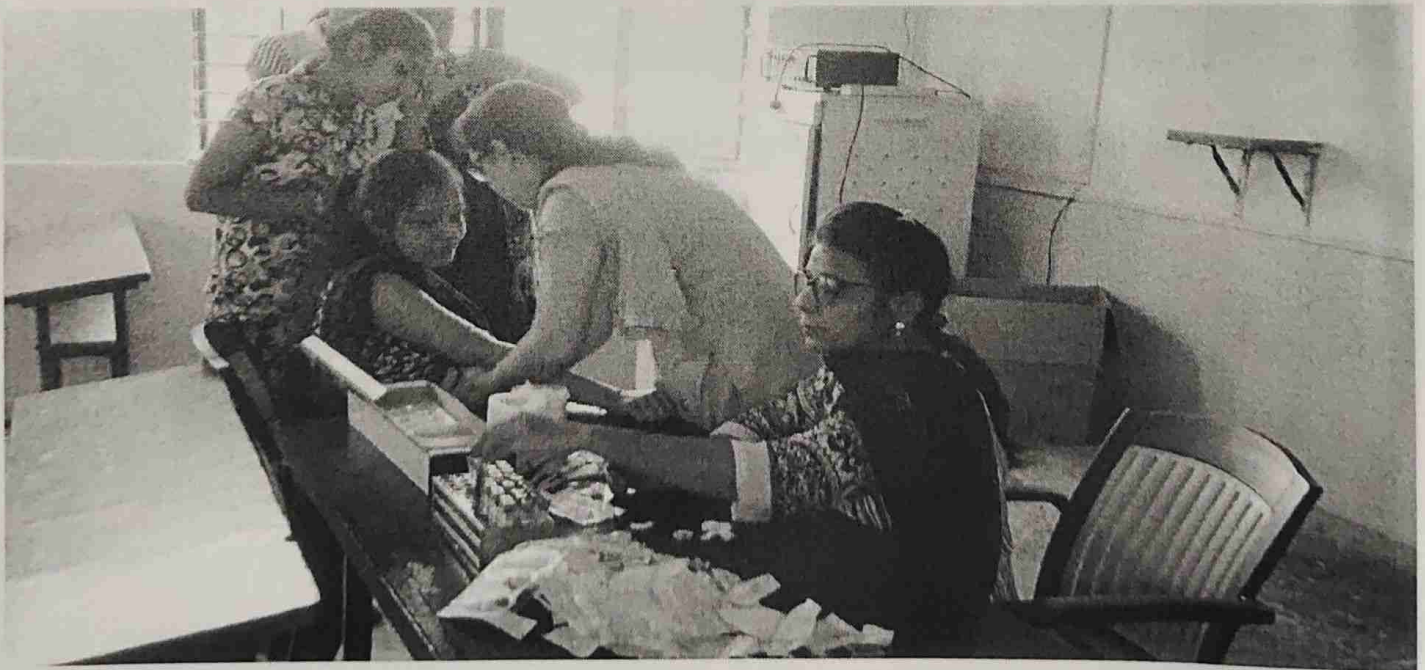




is detected with Thalassemia. Further doubt clearing session was taken to clear the doubts of the students & staff those who participated for the same.

- e) The couple also opened a care centre called 'Balhatya Pratibandhak Griha' for pregnant & rape victims to help deliver their children.
- f) Savitribai Phule wrote many poems against discrimination and encouraged people to get educated.

Later on our Principal Dr.Vasant P. Mali concluded the whole program by honouring the great contribution of the Savitribai





Phule for the enhancement of the women in the society and the program ended by singing National Anthem.

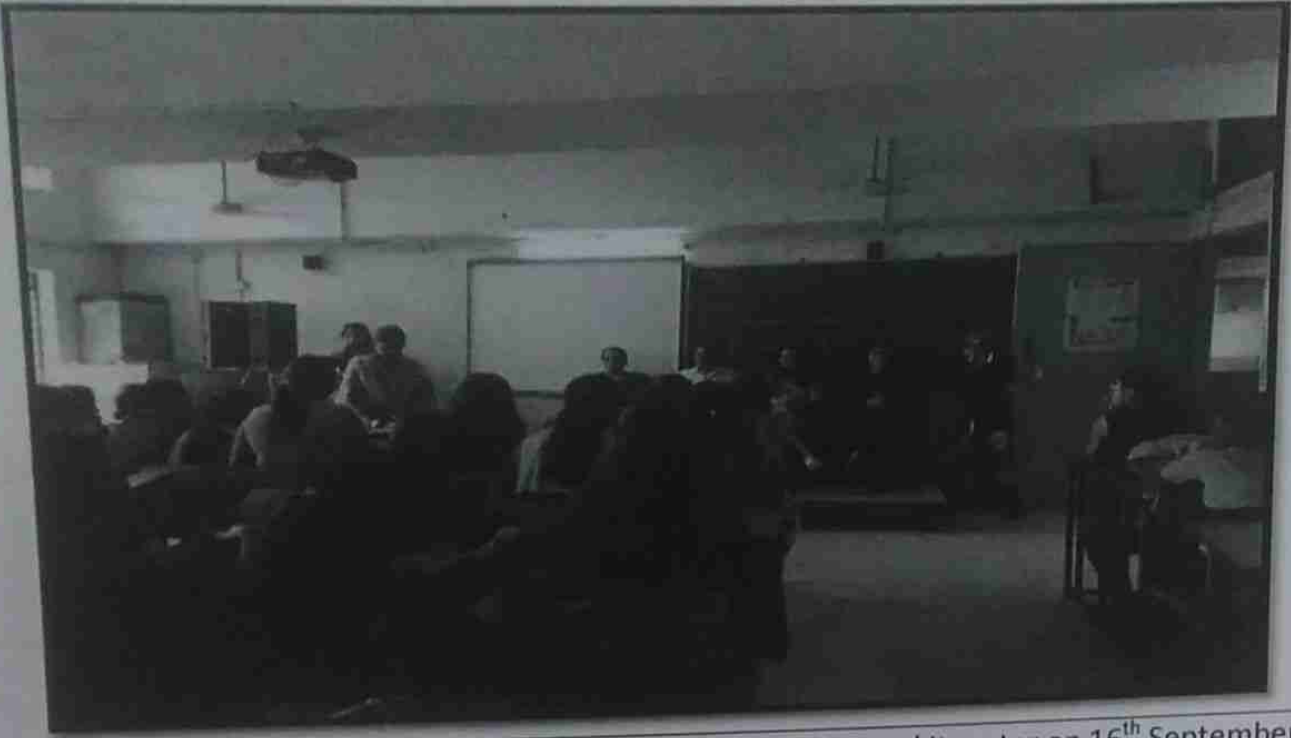

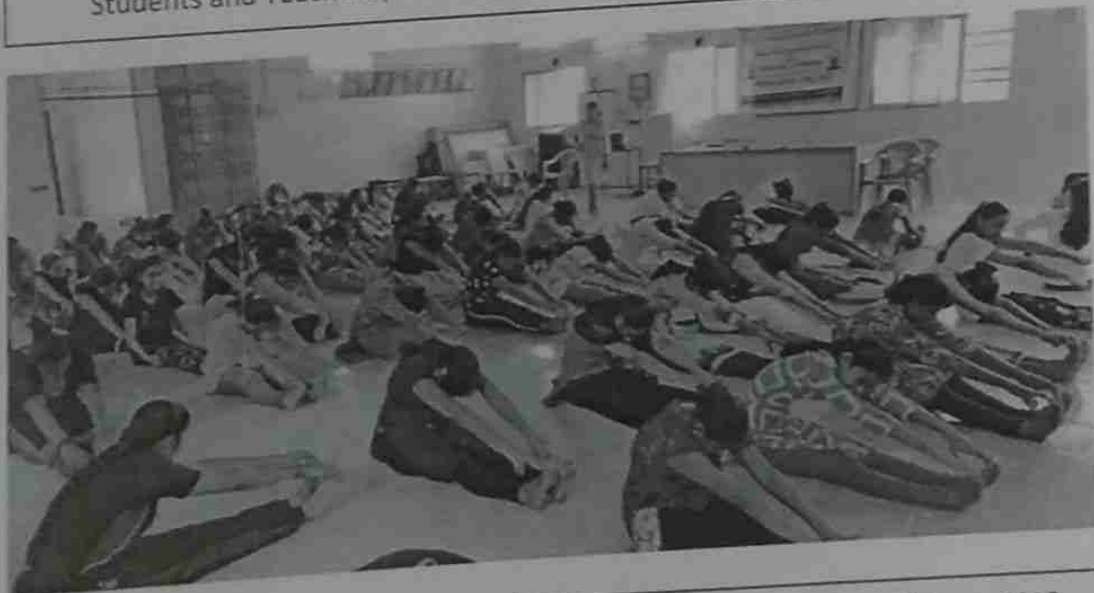

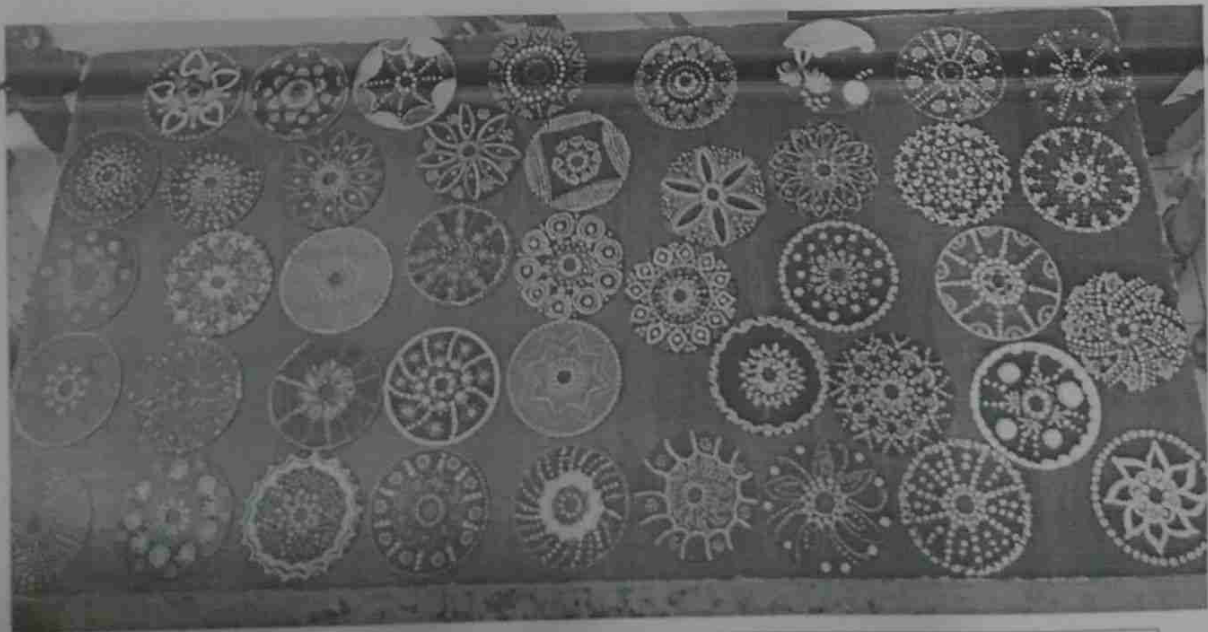



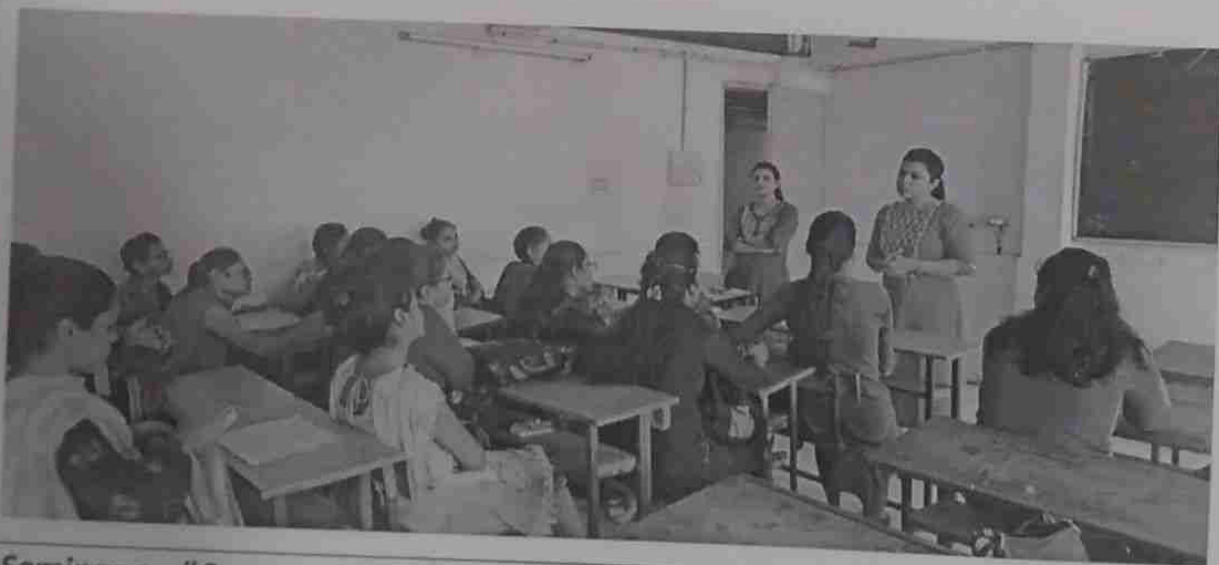

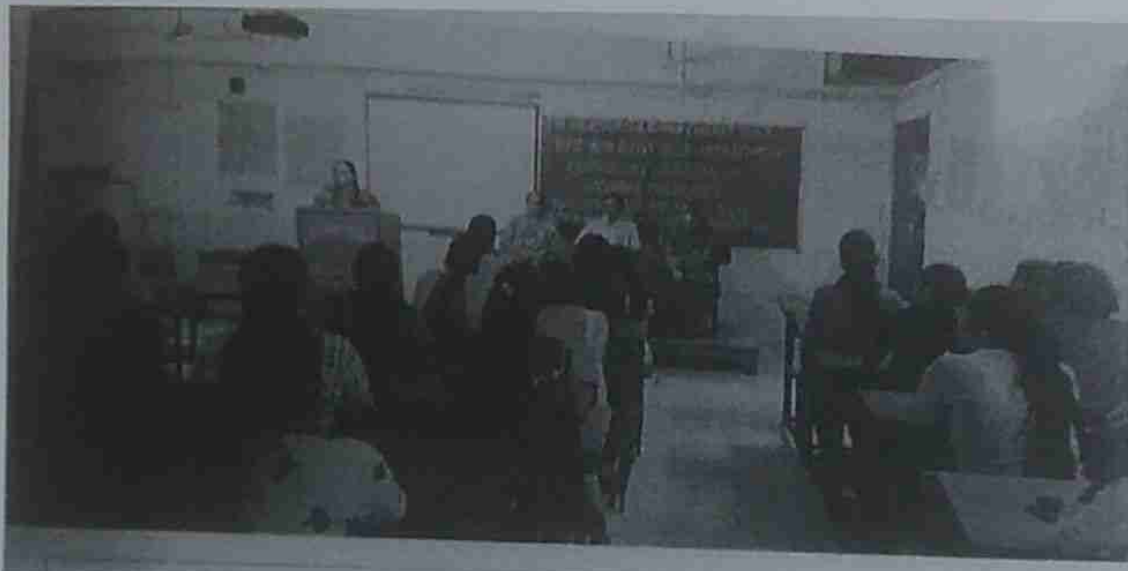

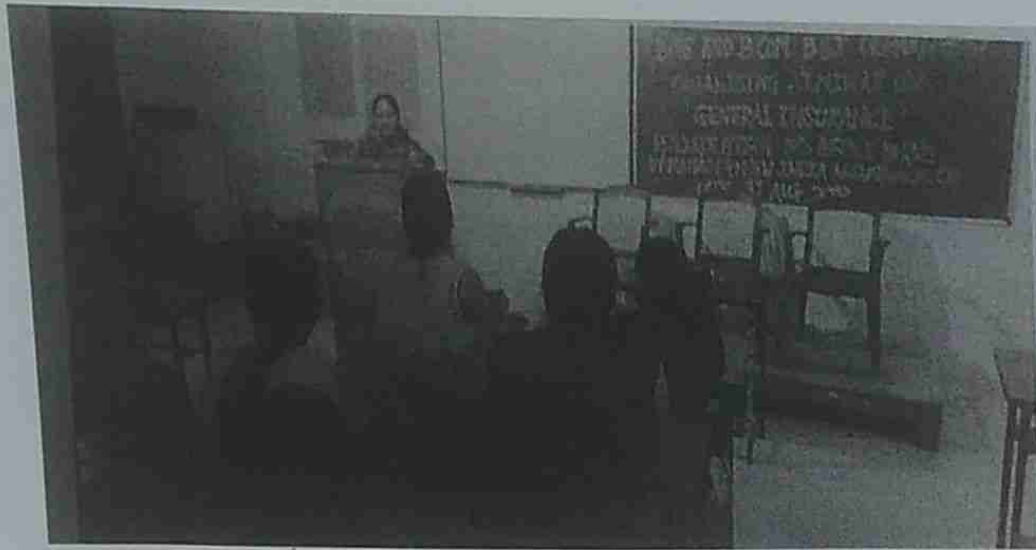
