

Report on seminar of Intellactual Property Right

A seminar on intellectual property rights was organized by the department of commerce on 27-01-2017. Ms. Sonam Kotwani, Professor of J. W. Sadhubella Girls College who is also a law practitioner was the resource person for the seminar. She provides the information regarding the strong enforced IPR, protect consumers and families. Strong IPR rights also help consumers make an educated choice about the safety, reliability and effectiveness of their purchases.

Prof. Sonam Kotwani stated about the types of IPR: patent, trademark, copyrights and trade secrets. A patent owner has every right to commercialize his/her patent including buying and selling the patent or granting a license to the invitation to any third party under mutually agreed terms, utility, design and plant are the three different categories that patents can fall under. She further stated that trademark are another familiar type of intellectual property rights protection. It is a distinctive sign which allows consumers to easily identify the particular goods or services that a company provides. Copyright covers tangible forms of creation and original work for eg: art, music, architectural drawing or even software codes. Finally trade secrets are the secrets of business. They are proprietary system, formulas, strategies or other information that is confidential.

Prof. Sonam Kotwani enlightened the students by stating intellectual property rights were in Indian context. She spotlighted that IPRs are legal rights governing the use of creations of the human mind. The recognition and protection of these rights is of recent origin. Patent design and trademark are considered as industrial property. With the trade related aspects of intellectual property rights agreement of world trade organization India also enforce the law of intellectual property rights. The Indian patents and design act of 1911 established for the first time in India a system of patent and design. The IPD act 1911 was in force when India became independent on



15th august 1947.india has laws covering various areas of intellectual property like trademarks, patents, copyrights geographical indications, plant varieties, information technology, etc.



Initially Pidilite trainer explained design to be drawn on clothes. After drawing of design explanation was given regarding Neon liner painting. Total 17 students attended the workshop.










Owl design made by Neon liner painting by a student




Students Making Bottle Craft Decorations

Our speaker CA Mukesh Haseja stated in his speech that "GST aims at to replace all indirect Dur speaker CA Mukesh Haseja stated in his speech that "GST aims at to replace all indirect levied on goods and services by the Indian Central and State Governments. The need for GST in Indian Taxation System will add value at each stage and will set off the rates both at state and at central level. Introducing GST, will increase the efficiency of taxation, improves the economic growth and it will bring whole nation to one national market. Our present taxation system is very complex and very confusing, corruption chance is there, which leads to distrust of government, there are hidden tax for exports, whereas no charge applicable on Importing of Goods/Services from one state to another. Just to overcome these issues, Rajya Sabha introduced GST bill, which will bring transparency to taxation and consumer will get to know how much tax amount they are paying to government for sale/ purchase/

Tax Structure will be Simple: – At present, there are huge number of taxes that has to pay by consumers, with GST it will single tax to pay, which is much easier to understand. For businesses, accounting complexities will reduce and results less paperwork, which will save both time and money.

Tax revenue will increase: Simple tax structure will bring more tax payers and in return it will be revenue for government.

Boost to exports: If Indian market will be competitive in pricing, then more and more foreign players will try to enter the market, which results in more numbers of exporters and benefits to Indian Market.








The seminar was very knowledge gaining for the students.


State Level Webinar on Introduction to Intellectual Property Rights in India: Patents, Trademarks and Copyrights

She conducted the session with the help of PPT Presentation and interactive mode.









- 4) Types of Research.


