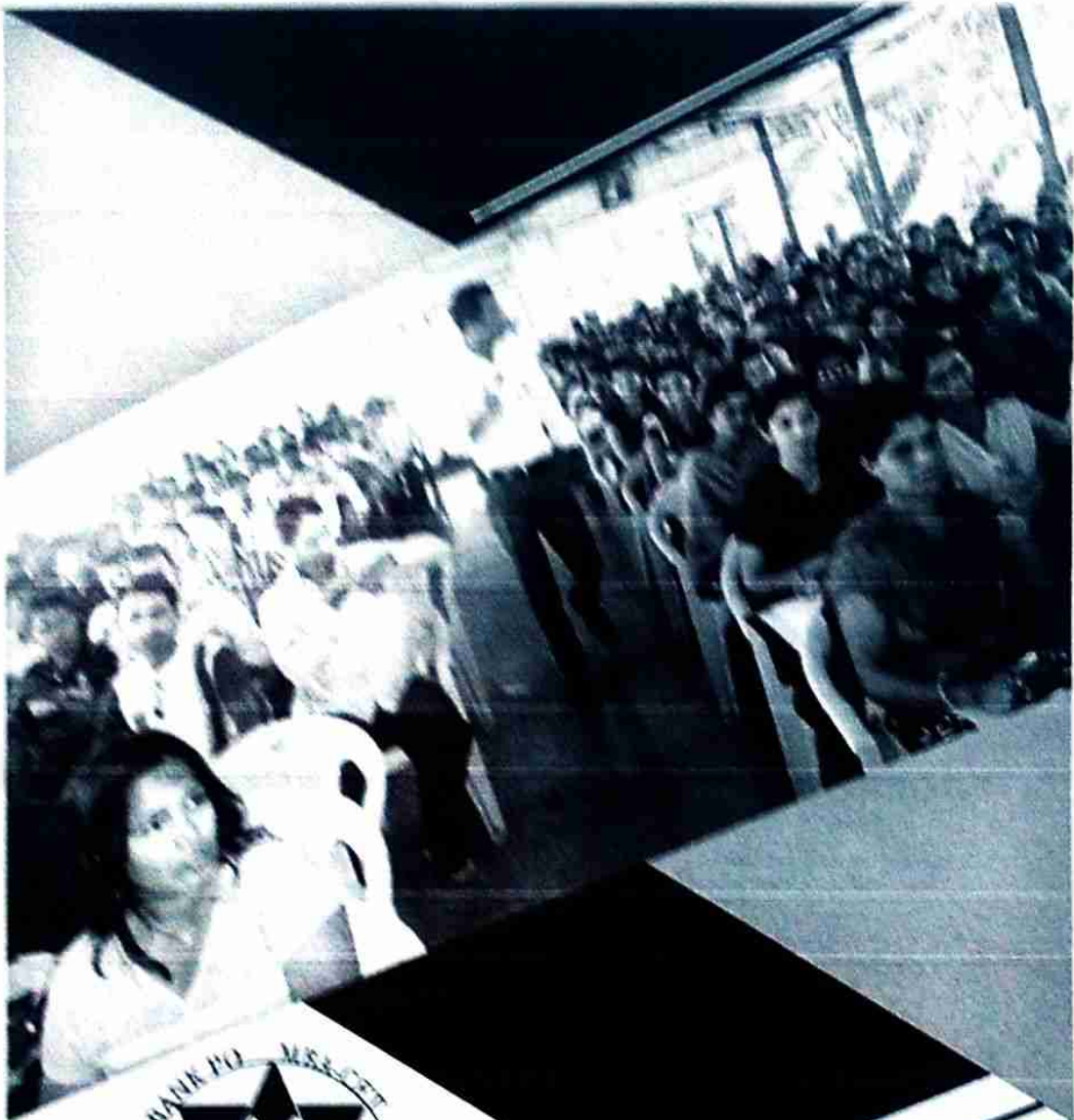

### Negative Marking

For all the above Exam 0.25 of the marks assigned to that question will be deducted as penalty.

### Cut-off score

Each candidate will be required to obtain a minimum score in each section. There will be a second level cut-off point on total as per requirement. Depending on the number of vacancies available, cut-offs will be decided and candidates will be short-listed for interview.

### Common Interview in PSB's (PO/MT) and RRB's (Scale II & III)

Candidates who qualify in IBPS CWEs are called for a common interview coordinated by IBPS. Candidates who qualify in both the CWE and the common interview are listed in an order of merit. The order of preference for banks is obtained from candidates at the time of applying for the CWE. Based on the total marks (CWE + Common Interview) and the indication of the order of preference of banks and available vacancies, an offer from any one of the participating public sector banks is sent to candidates through a computerized system.





### Important for IBPS Clerical CWE

As per notification issued by the IBPS has discontinued interviews in the recruitment process for the Clerical cadre. Since clerical cadre recruitment is on a state-wise basis, it is necessary that candidates appear for the examination in any of the centers of that particular State/UT where the candidate is likely to apply for employment. The candidate is required to have proficiency in the official language of that State/ UT.

### STAFF SELECTION COMMISSION -COMBINED GRADUATE LEVEL EXAM

**VSA** offer training for SSC-CGL Exam, both for Tier I and Tier II. **VSA** also offers SSC- CGL as an extension course (add-on module) to the Bank PO course.

#### About the exam and posts

Staff Selection Commission conducts Combined Graduate Level Examination (SSC- CGLE) for recruitment to different posts, for which graduation from a recognized university is the minimum educational qualification. Recruitment for these posts is done in departments of Central Secretariat Service / Intelligence Bureau / Ministry of Railways / Ministry of External Affairs / Ministry of Defence / CBI and a few other Ministries / Departments! Organisations of the Central Govt.

#### Eligibility Criteria:

#### (1) Age

- i) Junior Statistical Officer: Max 32 years.
- ii) Assistant Section Officer (CSS, Railways, MEA, AFHQ) / Sin CBI: 20-30 Years.
- iii) Assistant Audit Officer/Assistant Enforcement Officer/SI in NIA / Divisional Accountant / Assistant Accounts Officer/Income Tax Inspector / Assistant Section Officer in IB / Inspector CBEC (Central Excise / Preventive Officer/Examiner) /Assistant/Superintendent in Other Ministries/Departments/Organizations: Max: 30 years.
- iv) Inspector of Posts: 18-30 Years.
- v) Tax Assistant CBEC: 20 — 27 Years.
- vi) All Other posts: 18- 27 Years.



## (2) Educational Qualification

(I) For post of Assistant Audit Officer/Assistant Accounts Officer:

(a) Essential Qualifications: Degree from any recognized University.

(b) Desirable Qualifications: Chartered Accountant or cost & Management Accountant or Company Secretary or Masters in Commerce / Masters in Business Studies or Masters in Business Administration (Finance) or Masters in Business Economics.

(ii) For post of Junior Statistical Officer: Bachelor's Degree in any subject from a recognized university or institute with at least 60% in Mathematics at 12<sup>th</sup> standard level OR Bachelor's Degree in any subject with Statistics as one of the subjects at degree level.

(iii) All other Posts: Degree from a recognized University or equivalent

**Note:** For posts of Assistant Section Officer - CSS & MEA, Computer Proficiency has also been prescribed as an Essential Qualification.

The marks obtained by candidates in Tier -I & Tier- II together, would determine the eligibility of the candidates to appear in Tier- III & Tier-IV.

The paper (Tier-III) comprises the writing of an Essay / Passage and Letter / Application writing. The question paper will be bilingual. Candidate will have the option to choose anyone medium.

The maximum marks for this section is 100 and duration is 60 minutes. The qualifying marks in Tier III would be 33%.

#### (d) Pattern of Tier- IV Examination

1. DEST (Data Entry Speed Test): FOR THE POST OF TAX ASSISTANTS (Central Excise & Income Tax) This test will be of a qualifying nature.
2. CPT (Computer Proficiency Test): For applicants for the post of Assistant Section Officer of CSS and MEA. CPT will be of a qualifying nature.

#### (e) Final Selection

The final merit will be prepared on overall performance in Tier-I Tier-II & Tier-III. There will be no sectional cutoff.

## STAFF SELECTION COMMISSION -CHSL 10+2

### SSC CHSL Exam Pattern 2020

There are three different phases, which a candidate is required to clear in order to get selected for various posts in the Government Offices.

1. SSC CHSL Tier I Exam is an Objective Multiple-Choice Question paper
2. Tier II exam is Descriptive Paper in English/Hindi
3. Tier III is the Computer Proficiency Test.



#### Eligibility:

Age 18-27 years as per the norms of board.

**Educational Qualification:** The candidate should be a 12<sup>th</sup> pass from a recognized board or university SSC 10+2.

## SSC CHSL Tier-II Exam Pattern

**SSC CHSL** Tier-II is a descriptive type of test. In order to assess the writing skills of candidates in English/Hindi, the candidates have to qualify Tier-II. This written test comprises of an **Essay of 200-250 words** and **Letter/Application writing of about 150-200 words**. **The minimum marks that a candidate needs to score in SSC CHSL Tier-II are 33 per cent.**

- The total time duration of the exam is of 60 minutes and total marks are 100 marks.
- All the questions are based on the concepts of 10th standard.
- The total time duration is 80 minutes for candidates who are visually handicapped or suffer from cerebral palsy.

## SSC CHSL Tier- III Exam Pattern

The Tier III of SSC CHSL 2020 comprises of a couple of skill tests which are needed for selection to certain government posts. These include typing test, for which a candidate must have a 30wpm (Hindi Medium) and 35wpm (English Medium). The test duration is 15 minutes. For visually handicapped (40% disabled), 30 minutes will be provided. Finally, a merit list will be prepared after the typing test.

The final merit will be prepared on overall performance in Tier-I, Tier-II and Tier - III. However, the candidate will need to qualify all the tiers i.e., Tier-I, Tier-II and Tier -III separately. There will be no sectional cutoff.

### Staff Selection Commission – MTS

#### Eligibility:

Age 18-26 years as per the norms of board.

**Educational Qualification:** The candidate should be a 10<sup>th</sup> pass from a recognized board or university.

However, marks scored by the candidates in Paper-II will be used to decide merit in case more than one candidate score equal normalized marks in Paper-I.
- Paper-II will be held only for those candidates who meet the cut-off prescribed by the Commission in Paper-I for different categories.





Webinar was started with National Anthem.

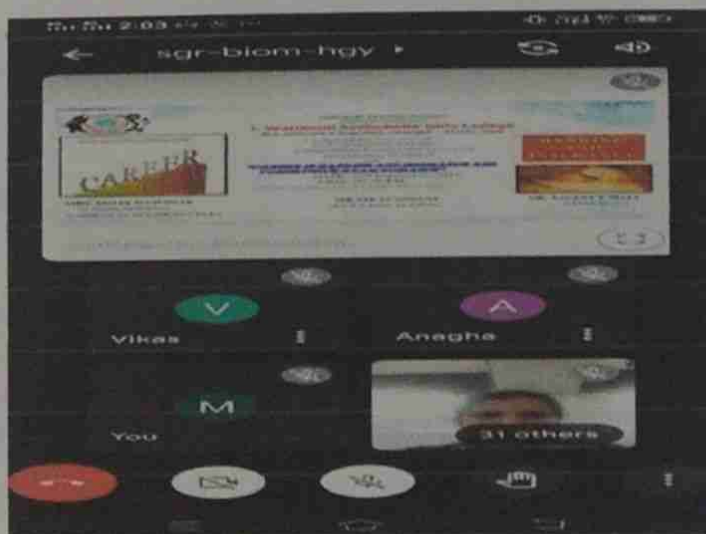
