Then by using fevicryl acrylic colour make deign on it

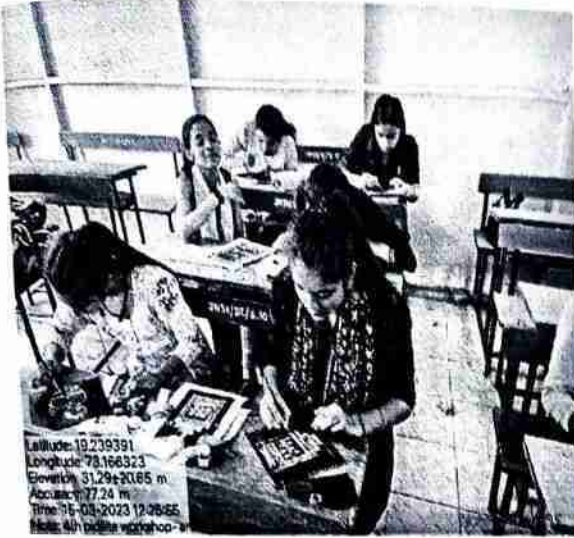
After that students start practicing on that

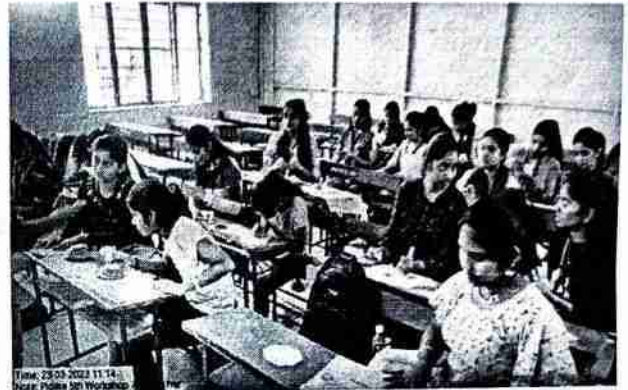

Department of Commerce organised education tour to Barclay's on Thursday 20th April, 2023.



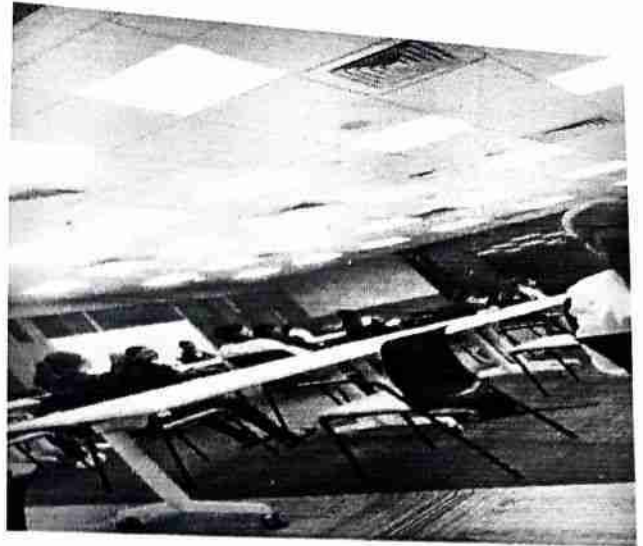
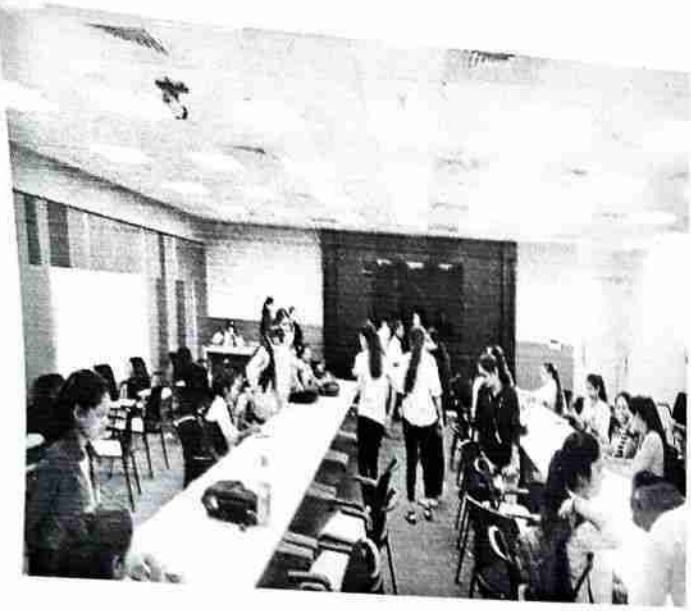
Students with Staff members for visit to Barclay's

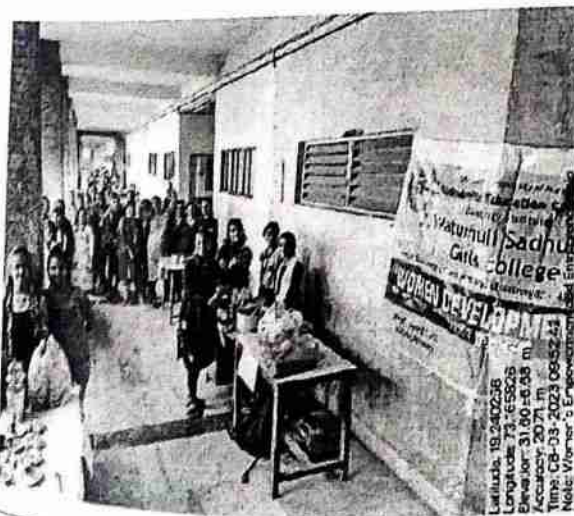
All the college students and school students were purchasing their breakfasts' items by the stalls.

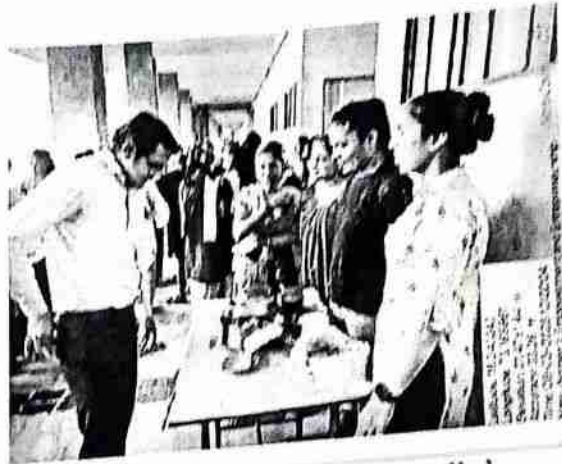
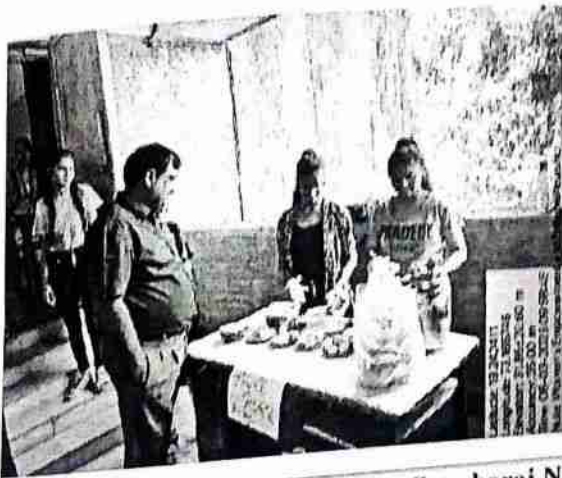
